## Culture

Soil should be slightly acid, ph 6.2 to 6.5 . One part leafmold, rotted manure and loam. Good drainage is necessary.

Light is important. Give as much strong light as possible without burning leaves, otherwise colors will not be bright.

Temperature should be 80 to 85 degrees, the higher the better. Reduce heat gradually to harden off plants. Start the bulbs in flats and place on steam flows if possible.

Water sparingly until sprouts and roots are 4 to 6 inches long, then shift to 5 or 6 inch pots. Never allow the pots to dry out when in full growth.

## "CULTURAL HINTS" FOR DOUBLES

Sowing Dates-For pots, November for 5's, and December for 4's for late April and May; for combinations, December and January for $21 / 2$ 's and 3's for April and May; for bedding, December and January for April and May sales.

Germination-Sterilized peats and leafmolds (if not strongly acid) are good mediums; so are various sterilized mixtures of soil with peat or other organic matter. Don't cover the seed except for perhaps a sheet of paper to keep from drying out. The surface of the flat must be moist till the roots have dug down into the soil. Keep them at 60-65 degs. nights till germination takes place, then 48-50 degs. and dry, but not wilting.

When transplanting a mixed flat, use the smaller seedlings as well as the larger ones, so you will obtain all colors.
