#### Culture

Soil should be slightly acid, ph 6.2 to 6.5. One part leafmold, rotted manure and loam. Good drainage is necessary.

Light is important. Give as much strong light as possible without burning leaves, otherwise colors will not be bright.

Temperature should be 80 to 85 degrees, the higher the better. Reduce heat gradually to harden off plants. Start the bulbs in flats and place on steam flows if possible.

Water sparingly until sprouts and roots are 4 to 6 inches long, then shift to 5 or 6 inch pots. Never allow the pots to dry out when in full growth.





Special Note—Seed should be sown late June or July for Winter flowering in Northern States. Late July or early August in Southern States. High temperatures retard germination. Select a cool location for the seed flats where there is good air circulation. Water sparingly but keep moist, until seedlings are well established. We recommend using sterilized soil and it should not be fertilized. Dust seeds with Proliferol or Hormo-Root before sowing.



### **CALCEOLARIA**

Approximately 10,000 S to 1/64 oz.

Calceolaria do not like direct sun but a light, airy place and temperature around 50 degrees.

For Easter flowering in a 6-inch pot, sow seeds June-July. To finish in 5-inch sow about August 15. For 4-inch sow about September.




### "CULTURAL HINTS" FOR DOUBLES

Sowing Dates—For pots, November for 5's, and December for 4's for late April and May; for combinations, December and January for 2½'s and 3's for April and May; for bedding, December and January for April and May sales.

Germination—Sterilized peats and leafmolds (if not strongly acid) are good mediums; so are various sterilized mixtures of soil with peat or other organic matter. Don't cover the seed except for perhaps a sheet of paper to keep from drying out. The surface of the flat must be moist till the roots have dug down into the soil. Keep them at 60-65 degs. nights till germination takes place, then 48-50 degs. and dry, but not wilting.

When transplanting a mixed flat, use the smaller seedlings as well as the larger ones, so you will obtain all colors.

NOTE: Double-face wreaths can be made easily by placing two selected greens face down under Hillman ring, and drawing stems up into clip with one stem on each side of ring. 
