

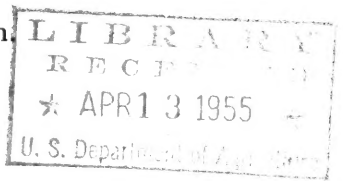

Chrysanthemums

These new Chrysanthemums, which we offered for the first time last year, have more than proven themselves as being very resistant to stunt, mildew and leaf drop. Besides taking the extreme winter cold in the garden, they took the worst drought in years without any watering this past summer. Our hats off to Dr. Emsweller's Department.

For the best display in the Fall follow a few simple directions as follows. Unpack at once when you receive them, and water moss around roots thoroughly. Nip the terminal bud and plant in good but not a very rich soil. Fertilize once only. Keep soil well weeded and aerated all summer. Nip the terminal buds on every branch every two to three weeks until July 15th. Never after that. In this way you will end up with a nice stocky compact plant full of flowers. If you do not nip the ends of the branches, you are going to have a long ugly plant that lies down on the ground.

TRUENESS OF NAME—Much time is spent checking labels, when plants are in bloom, to make certain that none are wrongly labeled, and every effort is made to keep the youngsters in their places, from propagation beds to field; but we raise thousands of plants in hundreds of varieties, and we could make mistakes. Should any prove untrue to name, please let us know, and we will do our best to correct the error.

PLANT QUALITY—We try our best to give you a plant that is well rooted, free of disease, and one that will meet your expectations, no matter what size your order calls for. We think we grow plants that are as good as the finest.

NURSERY SELECTION—If you are looking for something special in shape, or size, a visit to the nursery would be wise; you will be charged according to your selection only, not a premium.

IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO GUARANTEE THE LIFE of any plant. No one has that control. We have no way of knowing the treatment they will receive after they leave us. Some plants are perfectly hardy here in our nurseries, but that may not prove true where the Winter or soil is different. Read carefully our

CULTURAL DIRECTIONS. We make severe tests and give little or no Winter protection to prove hardiness, especially among the newer introductions. Drought often causes death to plants, and we cannot guarantee against that.

BREAKAGE EN ROUTE TO CUSTOMER—We advise shipping only by Express Collect, except for the small plants. Plants arrive in better condition by this

method. Once we have delivered shipment to Express Company they assume responsibility for safe delivery. If it arrives in poor condition notify the Express Agent from whom you receive shipment. He will immediately file your claim for damages which occur while in transit. We assume no responsibility for any damage after delivery to carrier.

TERMS—Please send cash, check, or money order with your order. Because of the perishable nature of the materials, no C. O. D. orders can be accepted. After your order has been placed, please do not ask us to change or cancel it. During the shipping season several thousand orders are handled, and it is impossible to look for any one particular order without spending hours of time. TERMS OF DELIVERY

CASH WITH ORDER

As we do a cash with order business only, all packing is done free of charge. Plants shipped Express Collect. Plants which are shipped in our specially designed box whereby each plant is supported and fits in its own individual compartment continue to grow in transit, as the plant itself is never disturbed. If the plants arrive in bad weather, no need to worry, just set in a cool shady location and keep watered. All plants shipped out of pots are wrapped in moisture retaining plastic, to assure safe arrival.
