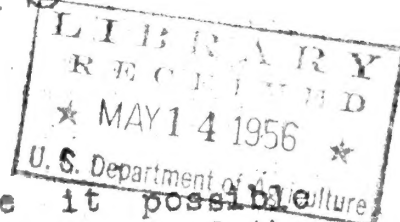


# TALL BEARDED IRIS
