PRICES in this list cancel all previous lists and are subject to change without notice. All prices quoted herein are f. o. b. our nurseries or cars at Westminster, Md. **Additional charge of 25% is made when customer selects extra specimen plant material.** New customers are requested to use printed stationery or enclose business card with first order. No order should be less than \$5.00. All orders are booked subject to prior sale or shipping restrictions.

TERMS are usual to those of established credit or whose responsibility is known to us. All open account invoices are payable 30 days net unless otherwise agreed. Cash, security or satisfactory references required from unknown parties. Interest at the rate of 6% per annum shall be charged on accounts from maturity. No stock will be sold directly or indirectly on consignment. Orders for shipment C.O.D. must be accompanied by a remittance for one-third of the amount to insure acceptance. These are our only terms and no salesman or representative is authorized to alter them in any way unless confirmed from the office in writing.

SHIPPING instructions are required with each order, whether by freight or express, stating route if you have a preference. In the absence of definite instructions, we will forward shipment the way we think best, without assuming responsibility. We are on the Western Maryland Railway which connects with the Pennsylvania and B. & O. Railroads and steamship lines in Baltimore. Freight Truck transportation is available direct from our nurseries. All shipments travel at risk and expense of purchaser.

CERTIFICATE: Westminster Nurseries Inc., is in Japanese Beetle area making it necessary to treat some kinds of stock before allowed to ship into certified zones with certificate.

PACKING: Boxing or baling is charged at actual cost. When cash accompanies order, please allow sufficient extra to cover packing; otherwise, same will be billed to purchaser collect. The cost of packing is naturally greater on certain bulky items such as Privet, etc. No packing charge is necessitated where stock is placed on cars or trucks in bulk.

NO ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED ON B & B MATERIAL FOR SHIPMENT BY COMMON CARRIER CRATED OR BOXED.

CLAIMS: All sales are made with the understanding that we shall not be liable in event of crop loss, or of damage from other causes over which we have no control. We will gladly correct any errors, but we cannot entertain any claims that are not made within five days after receipt of the stock or are made after the stock has once been accepted. Claims should be made promptly in writing on receipt of stock. Plants become your property upon delivery to transportation company and we cannot be responsible for loss, damage, or delay in transit. All orders booked are based on the distinct understanding that the purchaser agrees to the condition of sales as stated above.

GUARANTEE OF GENUINENESS: We will send out healthy, thrifty stock, true to name. If any nursery stock proves untrue to description or variety name under which it is sold, we hold ourselves in readiness on proper proof, to replace free of charge such stock that may prove untrue to description or name, or refund the original amount paid. We shall in no case be liable for any sum greater than the amount originally received for said stock.

Orders are always individually filled with fresh dug stock. Our customers appreciate the fact that we do not ship them stock that has dried out in the storage house.

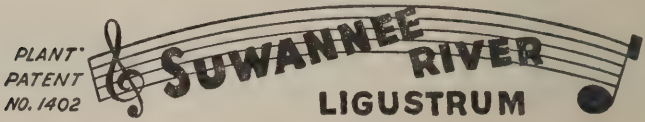

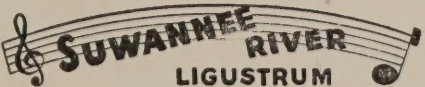
