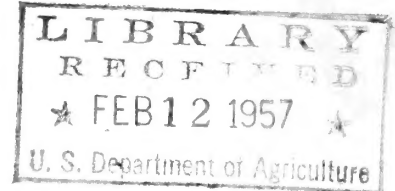

Mixed Seeds -

Gladiolus seeds are easy to grow. The time required to obtain bloom depends upon several factors, primarily lengths of growing seasons, and the particular parentage. Most seeds grow to be corms of a certain size upon which they then require a dormant period before further growth will start to attain them to a blooming size.

Prepare a seed bed in a coldframe located in full sun with good drainage. Good garden loam plus quantities of leaf mold, peat moss, compost and bone meal all well mixed is ideal. Plant seeds when temperatures get in the 70's or above to insure a better percentage of germination. Soak husked seeds 4 to 6 hours in warm water prior to planting. Plant seeds 5/8ths inch deep spacing rows 6 inches apart. After seedlings are well up mulch in between the rows with aluminum foil to help hold in the moisture, maintain a more uniform temperature, and control weeds. NEVER ALLOW SEED BED TO DRY OUT. Keep it moist always. Also shade young seedlings with a lattice work until they are about 6 inches tall and sturdy enough to take full sun. Label all plantings and keep a record. Very dilute applications of liquid fertilizers such as Rapid-Gro used about every 10 days will prove beneficial; caution is needed so as not to overdo it else the seedlings be burned out.

Care for the new corms the same as other gladiolus bulbs. When the blooms appear, be very critical and select only the distinctive and worthy of being named.
