We fertilize them each year with the correct commercial fertilizer to get the best color and most compact bodies possible. The trees are all several times transplanted, giving them the chance to develop the fine, fibrous root system, so necessary to easy, safe moving. Each tree is given careful, individual attention in shearing so as to put them in the best possible balanced symetrical shape. Weeds are eliminated and the ground kept moist by constant horse cultivation and hand hoeing. Spraying, when necessary, is done to rid the nursery of any insect pests. Thus we grow some of the best specimen stock to be found anywhere in this section of the country. When you are in the vicinity, drop in at our nursery, and let us show you our stock.
