LITTLE FAIRY. The unsurpassed beauty of Auratum $x$ Rubellum hybrids growing for 10 years in our gardens. There are no better true pinks in the lily family than come from these crosses.

LITTLE FAIRIES-(Auratum x Rubellum) Strain of the finest real pink trumpet lilies in existence. $4^{\prime \prime}$ to $8^{\prime \prime}$ flowers blush pink to deep pink of Rubellum, on plants that are usually under 2 feet tall. They come up later than most lilies and miss the late spring frosts but they are earlier to bloom than most other lilies. TAWNY TIGER (Yellow Tiger x Red Umbellatum x Dauricum Wilsonii) Mixture that carries the multiple bloom habit of Dauricum Wilsonii giving a very long bloom season over 2 months. They are fertile and some carry bulbils. Up to four ft . tall in three years from seed with 30 buds of flat outfacing flowers, orange to yellow shades heavily spetted. $\$ 5.00$ each, flowering size. NEPALENSE-This exotic Oriental Lily is a gorgeous novelty. Bell shaped nodding flowers have chartreuse petals with maroon purple center. Enchanting night fragrance. Rare. $\$ 3.00$ each.
TWINKLE-Pure white Speciosum type flowers with carmine blotch in center of each petal. Reflexed like a Tiger Lily. High bud count with up to 75 blooms on one stem. Formosanum like seed, growth like Henryi. Flowering size $\$ 5.00$ ea. Seed $\$ 1.00$ pkt.
SUNSET LILIES—PARDALINUM GI-GANTEUM-Bright red tips shading to yellow center, slightly spotted reflexed flower. They are one of the hardiest garden lilies and will grow anywhere. CROFT EASTER LILIES. They are the largest flowered Easter Lily in commercial production. They are low growing in the field but can be planted in semishade to gain height. Excellent for border use. Many large trumpet flowers bloming in late June and July. Force these for Easter in your windowgarden or small home greenhouse. CAMEO HYBRIDS (Auratum $\times$ Japonicum) Our strain similar to the Pfeiffer Hybrids that created such a sensation in the Eastern Lily Shows and similar to Edgar L. Kline's strain. Larger flowers than the Little Fairies in trumpet to bowl shape, in shades of pink and white, some clear and some spotted. Spicy fragrance. About 2 feet tall. Bloom season varies with the type of Auratum used as the seed parent but most of them are July bloomers. Flowering size $\$ 7.50$ each, Small seedling bulbs $1 / 2$ to $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ diameter .75 each, $\$ 7.50$ per dozen. Seed $\$ 1.00$ per packet.

BLOOD TIGER-A small early, vividly brilliant blood red Tiger Lily that multiplies rapidly by bulbils and bulblets also sets seed readily. Usually under 2 ft , and blooms in June. Up to 15 blooms to the stem.

YELLOW CALLAS - Purple Hearted Yellow Callas-Zantedeschia Melanoleuca-Lemon Yellow with purple throat. These add an unusual color combination to the garden. ## ATOMIC HYBRIDS

These 4 pictures are samples of the variations of (Speciosum $\times$ Auratum) X (Auratum $\times$ Rubellum) hybrids. They are mainly flat to bowl shat established bulbs. Some have yellow bands extending part way out in the petals and some have pink to red bands. The colors, shape, size of flowers, and heights of the individual plants are determined by how much of each parent has been used to produce the plant. They are all hardy, vigorous garden lilies blooming outside for Mother's Day, more for Decoration Day, and through June and July, instead of August and September. $1 / 8$ to $1 / 4$ Rubellum is enough to predominate for early flowering time and contributes a good portion of the lovely pinks so desired for gardens, cut flowers, and potted plant

These hybrids should more than double the range in which Rubrum type lilies can be grown successfully as they are later to emerge than Rubrum and will be through blooming before the serious heat of summer. Some of the hybrids selected from this group will produce the finest forcing lilies in existence with plants under $18^{\prime \prime}$, flowers $4^{\prime \prime}$ to $9^{\prime \prime}$ diameter in a whole range of colors from snow white to blood red and forcing in under 60 days. Specially selected seedlings from these hybrids will give flowers from May to October, the longest flowering season ever tied into a group Most of them carry the lovely perfume fragrance of Rubellum or blends of it intensified by the Auratum, Punctatum, and Rubrum. For those
Mos who do not care for fragrance we have selections without fragrance.

SPECIOSUM $\times$ AURATUM $\times$ (AURATUM $\times$ REBULLUM). These are exceptionally fine Rubrum type lilies with flowers larger and flatter than the Rubrum. Some have Rubrum coloring, while others are deep pink, and a few outstanding ones are red. The interesting spotting on these flowers gives them added character. The plants are from one to four ft. tall with $3^{\prime \prime}$ to $9^{\prime \prime}$ blooms. Most of these hybrids have Auratum Praecox as the Aurotum parent and some will flower a little earlier than the other groups. These hybrids conrain more variety for season, color, height and fragrance and shape than any crosses seed right in the field.

## A Rainbou of Reds and Pinks With 5" to 10" Flamers

| PARKMANI HYBRIDS-(Speciosum $\times$ Auratum). Hybrids of Speciosum $\times$ Auratum giving the vigor and garden dependabilitv of Rubrum with flowering sizz of Auratum. They are usually intermediate in shape between the huge bowls of Auratum and the reflex of Speciosum Rubrum. The flowers are 5 to 10 inches across and range in color from snow white, white with pink dots, and various pink markings to deep blood red. Many have a pink or red ray or band giving the appearance of Red Banded Auratums but with the Speciosum Rubrum giving them a greater longevity in the garden. These are the showiest lilies in existence for late blooms, July. August and September with 3 to 6 ft . stems, with up to 35 flowers. Some are earlier to bloom than Jillian Wallace and some re later. These along with the Little Fairy strain should be used by the millions as companion plants to azaleas, rhododendrons, and camelias in foundation plantings to brighten up our summer gardens azaleas, thododendrons, and camelias in foundation plantings to orighten up our summer gaddens during the tourist season. Azaleas, camellias and thododendrons are beautifal in the winter months but during the tourist season in June, July, and August there are no blooms. With heads of 5 to 25 flowers up to a foot across topping this foliage along our highways <br> the breath taking beauty would attract tourists by the thousands. |

BLACK BEAUTY-(Henryi x Speciosum Rubrum). It was a blue ribbon winner at the North American Lily Society Show in 1957. It was judged the darkest red Speciosum type lily ever exhibited, and it is the most vigorous Rubrum type lily we have ever grown. It carries from 1 to 4 blossoms from stem bulblets and we have had up to 35 blooms per plant on well established bulbs. It adds the vigor of Henryi to the Rubrum group and is a SUPER Fairyland Hybrid.
