1. Prior to [redacted], neither barracks installations nor Polish or Soviet troops were seen in Fabianice (Q 52/O 82). An empty stone building and two low wooden barracks buildings, capable of housing approximately 100 soldiers, were situated about 100 meters east of the MO (Militia) Office.
2. The recruiting office for the Lask (Q 52/O 71) district was in the eastern sector of the town, on the eastern side of ul. Konstantinowska which runs north and south between ul. Partisanska and ul. Czerwony Armij.
3. The MO office, staffed by 15 men, was located in a four-story stone building west of ul. Wanda Wassilewska. It was subordinate to an MO office in Lask.
4. The UB (Security Police) office, with a staff of 20 men, was southwest of the MO office on ul. Wanda Wassilewska, opposite the Robotnik motion picture theater. UB personnel wore brown visor caps with a red band. The UB office had one truck.
