

5. Polish infantry, artillery, engineer, and air force units were located in and around Lodz. No Polish units were located in the city, nor were Soviet units observed. Infantrymen wearing grayish-green uniforms, round caps with golden eaglo emblems, and white-bordered epaulets were observed on the streets. They had long trousors with puttees. The artillerymen had red-bordered epaulots and wore boots without spurs with long trousers. The Polish Air Force personnel wore bluish-gray uniforms with open collars, gray shirts with black ties, long trousers. with laced shoes, and round caps with silver eagle emblems.

## Sieradz

6. On a visit paid to Sieradz (Q 52/0 42) in late 1950, 25X1X the barracks installation before the war was undamaged and occupied by Polish units. It was located northeast of the railroad station on the western bank of the Warthe diver, west of a small bridge. Prior to the war, it had quartered two infantry battalions, a horse-drawn artillery battalion, an AAA unit, and a signal its capacity was not fully utilized 25X1X

The barracks installation included two three-story buildings, about 80 to 100x30 meters, covered with tiled roofs, and another somewhat smaller three-story building, located in the space between the other two. Three stables and two storehouses, constructed of brick and arranged in one line, were located in the southern sector of the installation. The entire barracks area was about 1,500 x 500 meters.
