The flowers are large, and approach those of the pollen parent in shape. The sepals and petals are deep rosy purple; the front lobe of the lip is a very dark purple, richly coloured, the disc being traversed with rich golden yellow veins.

This is the variety exhibited by Mons. G. Mantin Olivet, France, and is a very free grower.
