The collage of our loves those first years of freedom pass before our eyes. Bittersweet feelings make us smile as we realize the time has come to reach out for more of this life into which we have been born.

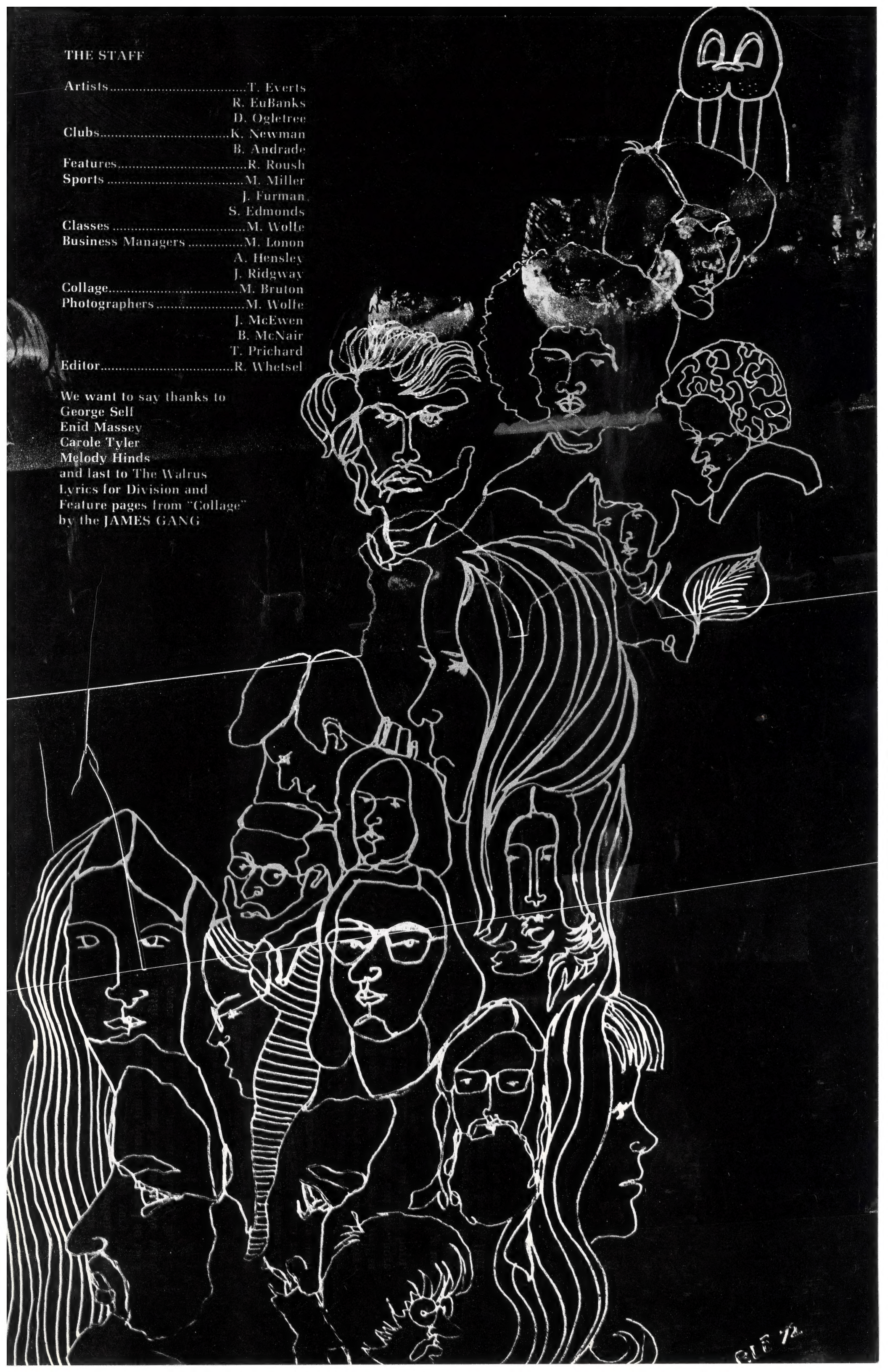
And, when the days have gone by us, and we cling to our memories we will look back to our youth. It is then that we will most poignantly remember the beauty that greeted our first steps into the world.
