## KERRY TRIP 1946.

28<sup>th</sup> May 1946 (Tuesday). Left Dublin by 10 A.M. train, arrived Tralee 7 P.M., where met by car & drove to Clohane at NE foot of Brandon Mt., where stayed. After heavy rain on 27<sup>th</sup>, rain again early today, but cleared about 8 A.M. & only showers during day; strong, to gale, SE. wind with showers, dropping in evening, where rain came on at Clohane about 10 P.M.

In Templemore station, Co. Tipperary, took a ♂ Aspilota (Synaldis) passicornis on carriage window: not kept.

In marshy ponds N. of railway <sup>+ 1 mile W. of Banteer</sup> W. of Mallow, Co. Cork, saw our first Osmonda - a very fine show; Euphorbia <sup>hibernica</sup> not seen for some miles further west & Osmonda very rarely until is crossed the divide into the Killarney basin & N. Kerry; N. of railway & 1 mile NE. of Rathcoole, saw a curious elongate, dry, turlough - shown as a lake on 1/2 Ord. map, but today dry except possibly at extreme E. end, not visible from carriage.

29<sup>th</sup> May 1946. After gale (SE) & rain all night, gale continued with driving misty rain till mid day, sometimes heavier & sometimes clearing, with sun often visible, walked for a mile or so towards Brandon Village & back & watched birds very wetting!

14th August 1946. A very nice day after a terrible day of gale + wind on 12th + heavy cold showers + N. wind on 13th. Left home in car at 10 A.M. & drove to far end of Burtas Bay Co. WI. arriving at about noon, as we had stopped for a few minutes at top of hill S. of Rathnew to admire the view of the Wicklow hills & immediately look at position of the Junkers plane which crashed almost on summit of Dorce on Monday (12th) afternoon with French Girl Guides - nobody being killed!

Wind W. & light in morning, but a sudden cold N.E. wind came in off the sea at 12.30 & lasted for half an hour; then wind SE slight & later SW. & the W. & finally N. at 4.30 PM an obvious gin formed of hills to N & NW. & as we left for home at 5 P.M. it had reached the ridge of hills S. of Wicklow; we drove through it near Redcross & then for miles on flooded roads & out into sunshine. Another very heavy shower from N. hit Dublin at 7.30 P.M. & lasted 15 minutes.

The rain on 14th was not so heavy as on 13th.

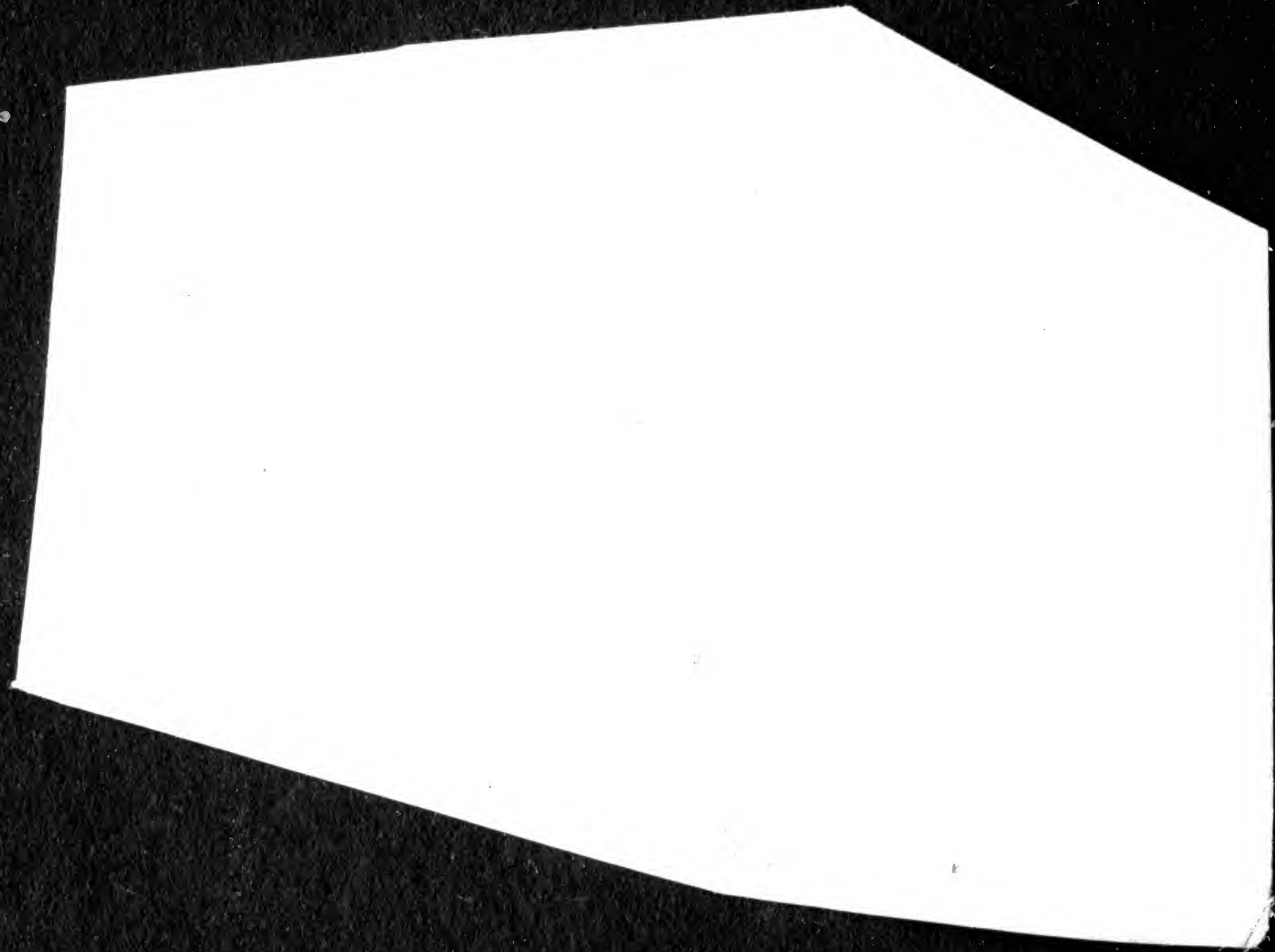
