*Rensselaeria* collected June 2  
 from NE cor. SE 1/4 SE 1/4 28-27 N-2E  
 0.3 miles S on Pottawatomie Point Rd  
 of US 24, and about 100' west  
 of Pot. Pt. rd., Logansport (7 1/2')  
 Ind., Indiana.

June 2

West side Frame Stone by about center  
NE 1/4 27-27N-2E, Logansport (7 1/2') □  
Stromatopora beds on west side  
quarry 12' unconformable with  
Deliffian, showing slight relief (6")  
where contact was seen. Tom  
records 5 feet of ss at base but  
not continuous. Limestone light  
gray, without definite bedding.  
Dominate by Stromas, essentially  
a congl. of them. Corals not well  
represented, less than 10% of  
the fauna make up. Stringot  
in patches, mostly on surface  
Extend down 18". Stromas worn  
and all out of place and the vast  
majority at an angle or upside  
down. Stromas up to 3 1/2' seen  
upside down. One truncated and  
overlain by Logansport ls.

On south wall of quarry 11' of  
gray ls is overlain by  
14' of Logansport, strongly  
crinoidal, many brachiopods,  
different corals and Stromas  
especially a broad flat one  
with corrugated base
