The following eight belong to the Natural Order *Liliææ*, viz. *Brodiaea*, *Calliprora*, *Conanthera*, *Cylobotrya*, *Laehenaria*, *Massonia*, *Ornithogalum* and *Seilla*; to *Amaryllidææ*, *Leucodjum* and *Teeoplulia* (Pöppig); *Arum* to *Aræææ*; *Asclepias* to *Aselepiadæææ*; *Cyclamen* to *Primulæææ*; *Oxalis* to *Oxalidæææ*; *Satyrium* to *Orchidæææ*; *Tropæolum* to *Tropæolæææ*; and *Wachendorfia* to *Hemodoræææ*.

EXPLANATIONS.

The letters *aa* indicate the earliest and most proper sorts for forcing in pots or glasses; *a* such as are more proper for pots than water. Those not designated by *aa* or *a* are late flowering sorts which will not bear forcing. These remarks apply to the first seven pages of the Catalogue, viz. from *Hyacinths* to *Early Tulips*, the whole of which are proper for the open flower-borders also. The Bulbs from *Double Tulips* to *Winter Aconites* (pages 8 to 13) are adapted for the open borders only, except those with an*, which may also be grown in pots; and those marked †, which are proper for a greenhouse, but will thrive out of doors with a little protection. *Anemones*, *Turban Ranunculus*, *Snowdrops*, *Aconites*, *Fritillaries*, and a few others are sometimes forced, but with uncertain success. The *Amaryllidaceæ* are chiefly greenhouse or stove plants; the *Iridaceæ* are adapted for the greenhouse or frame, but they succeed well out of doors.

October and November are considered the most proper months for general planting. English Iris and Fritillaries ought not to be deferred beyond that time; many others, however, succeed well when planted much later, though it is preferable to plant in good time.

* * * Those *Hyacinths* to which the price per dozen is affixed, are such as can be strongly recommended. 3 Roots may be had at the same rate as 12. Single Roots are charged the retail price.
