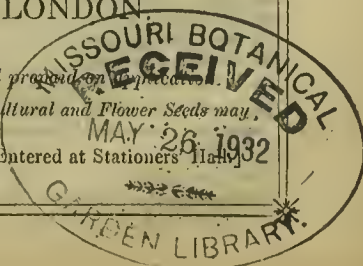

Those with ** are for the stove or greenhouse, but most proper for the former. Those marked with a † are adapted for the greenhouse, frame or open borders. In very severe winters a little protection is desirable. Some of the *Amaryllis* are now called *Hippeastrum*, as *Amaryllis aulica*, or *Hippeastrum aulicum*. Of the Bulbs marked †, and particularly of such as are not expensive, as *Ixia*, *Sparaxis*, *Tritonias*, &c. &c. J. C. would recommend at least 3 Bulbs of a kind, for a pot or clump, as a single bulb is insufficient for effect.
