

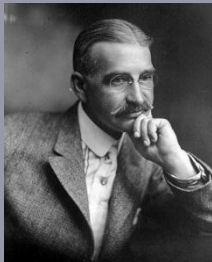

It is the third volume in "the successful Aunt Jane Series," following *Aunt Jane's Nieces* and *Aunt Jane's Nieces Abroad*. *Aunt Jane's Nieces at Millville* picks up the story of the three cousins, Patsy Doyle, Beth De Graf, and Louise Merrick, soon after their return from Europe in *Aunt Jane's Nieces Abroad*. As in that earlier book, their benign and eccentric millionaire Uncle John devotes much of his fortune to helping others — an effort managed by Patsy's father, Major Doyle.
