Thomas D'Arcy McGee was an Irish refugee and a father of the Canadian confederation. His work on Irish history is comprehensive, encompassing twelve books. Book 9 subtitled "From the Accession of James I Till the Death of Cromwell," addresses the early Stuart period's unsettled history and the
