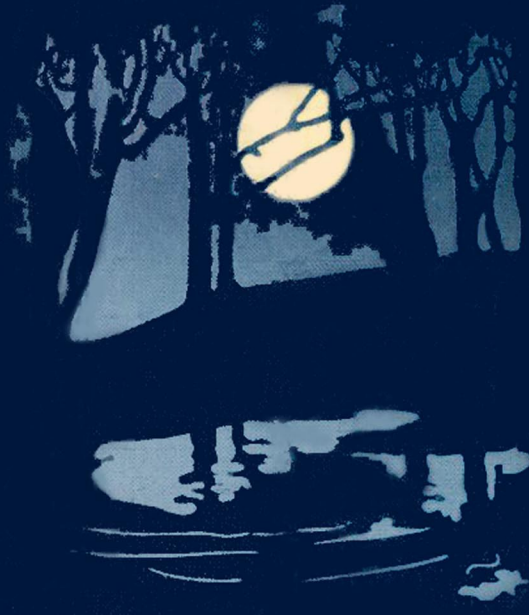


THE FOUR-POOLS MYSTERY
