MATERIAL FALLACIES ARE: ACCIDENT; AFFIRMING THE CONSEQUENT; CONVERSE ACCIDENT; IRRELEVANT CONCLUSION; BEGGING THE QUESTION; FALSE CAUSE AND FALLACY OF MANY QUESTIONS. (ADAPTED FROM WIKIPEDIA)
