For varieties not listed herein, also for terms and conditions, see Spring Trade List. Prices quoted are net and apply only on orders accepted after date of this Bulletin.

Rates—Fifty trees of not less than ten of a variety furnished at hundred rates; three hundred at thousand rates. Broken lots of less than ten of a variety will be charged at higher rates.

Storage Facilities—Our superior storage facilities enable us to carry stock through the winter in prime condition. We have special facilities for holding stock in dormant condition for late trade. Our superior equipment throughout enables us to handle orders promptly.

On account of sales made while list is being printed, quantities offered are only approximately correct.

We desire to call special attention to the high quality of our stock, and to our superior equipment and organization for handling our business.

Quality and Service are the Most Essential Features to Consider in Buying.

GRADE COUNT—For the benefit of customers we give an approximate grade count of number, size and variety unsold at this date, of our principal surplus. Customers in ordering should give second choice in varieties and sizes as far as possible, especially if in a hurry for shipment, as we do not substitute or make any changes without permission.

HEIGHT AND CALIPER—Height given of Fruit Trees is approximate and represents the average height of most varieties. Slow growing kinds will fall short of height specified, as it is intended that the caliper shall govern.
