After delivering to the forwarder, all shipments are entirely at purehaser's risk and should any loss or delay oeeur, the transportation eompany alone can be held responsible.

Priees quoted are net, cost of packing to be added. Quotations are limited to the spring of 1912, and are subjeet to ehange without notiee. Fifty trees, not less than ten of a variety, will be furnished at hundred rates, and three hundred at thousand rates.

In the seleetion of varieties we will follow the wishes of the purehaser as far as the assortment of stock will permit, but we reserve the right to substitute unless expressly ordered to the contrary. If the grade of stock ordered is exhausted, we reserve the right to fill the order with a higher grade of stoek, at the priee, however, of the grade ordered.
