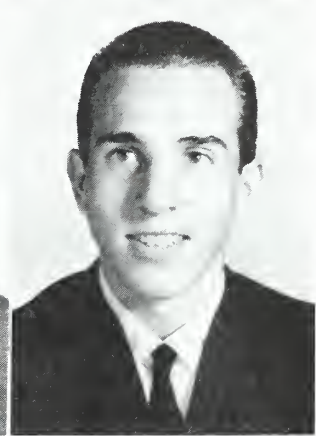
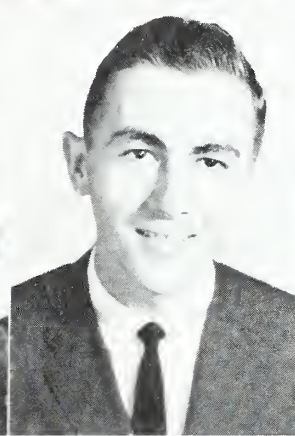
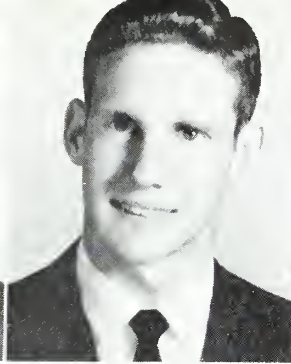
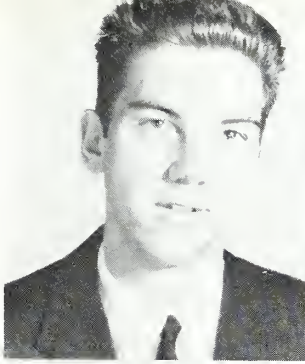
## THE SENIOR CLASS

## History of the Class of 1961

But things began to fit together as we elected Jerry Little as our class president; Ronnie Barlow, vice-president; Susu Tuttle, secretary; Edgar Ketchie, treasurer; and Sara Anne Trott and Ronnie Phillips, student council representatives. Mrs. Charles Query, our advisor, guided us as we produced the "Sophomore Follies," our money-making project.

We entered the new world of being juniors as we held our first class meeting of the year. Chosen as officers were Edgar Ketchie, president; Ronnie Barlow, vice-president; Brenda Neal, secretary; George Oehler, treasurer; and Susu Tuttle and Denny White, representatives to the student council. In student government, Sara Anne Trott served as treasurer and Ronnie Phillips as secretary. Our advisor, Mr. Dan Boone, showed us the way through the fascinating maze of junior year events. We remember with fondness and delight the fabulous trip to Washington, D. C.; the Junior-Senior on the theme, "Sea of Dreams"; the junior play, CHARLEY'S AUNT; and the day the long-awaited class rings arrived. Preparations for the senior year began with the selection of Doris Phillips and Don Smith as editors of the ALBROKAN and the BROWN HIGHLIGHTS. The student body chose as cheerleaders Brenda Neal (chief), Glenda Lee, Becky Withers, Kaye Sloop, and Brenda Wright. Ronnie Phillips and Sara Anne Trott were elected president and vice-president, respectively, of the Student Organization.

The year for which we had all been waiting finally arrived, and we were immediately caught up in the "senior whirl." At the first of innumerable class meetings, we chose as our leaders Bob Crutchfield, president; George Oehler, vice-president; Susan Gribble, secretary; Denny White, treasurer; Harriet Maulden, chaplain; and Susu Tuttle and Kenneth Murray, council members. Glenda Lee, as Miss Brown High, represented the beauty and talent of our class in two Christmas events, and Susu Tuttle was elected by the class as its Miss Hi Miss. Homecoming was reigned over by Queen Dian Barlow, and the May Day festivities were held in honor of Queen Gail Cheek and her maid of honor, Jo Ann Lindsay. Dari Daves and Allen Rainey were chosen as mascots, and the class selected "The Past—Our Guide; The Future—Our Dream" as its motto and the purple orchid and lavender and silver as its flower and colors.

In the long list of senior activities, one or two have attained the forefront in our minds. How could we ever forget the thousands of hot dogs we sold at the home football games? And we are justly proud of our Little Wonder football team which did not lose a game in its march to the association co-championship. We are also proud of our basketball, baseball, wrestling, and track teams and their fine records. The election of superlatives gave us the opportunity to honor the outstanding members of our class, and the selection of a college occupied many of our minds. The classes, assemblies, pep meetings, exams, and all of the other events of the year made it a truly memorable one.

A number of our class members were honored by being selected for membership in the four honor organizations. 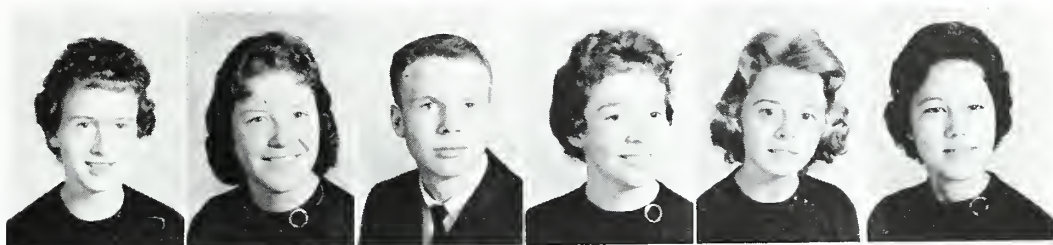
We couldn't forget the Washington trip if we tried. Never have we had so much fun learning of
