While there, he acted as a critical observer of these societies almost as if returning a status report on their progress. This can be compared to the style of his *Pictures from Italy* written four years later, where he wrote far more like a tourist. His American journey was also an inspiration for his novel *Martin Chuzzlewit*.
