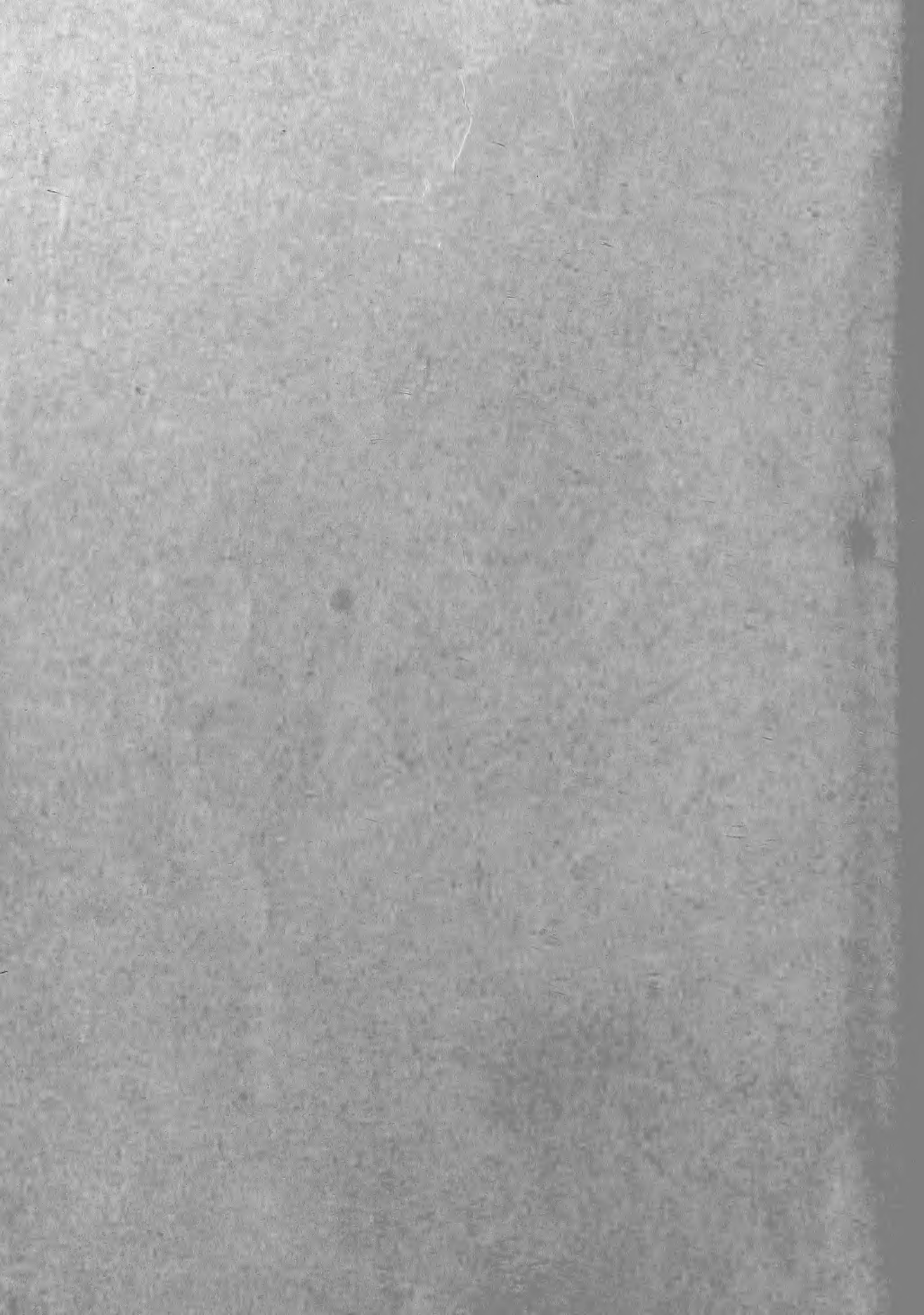

The scientific names in these lists are based on the official Appendices I and II as at 29 August 1986 and Appendix III as at 13 November 1986, and on previous editions of the official Appendices, produced by the CITES Secretariat. The English common names are derived from many different sources but the main criterion for selection has been aptness. The majority are included in Common Names of Species Listed on Appendices I and II also produced by the CITES Secretariat.

INTERPRETATION

1. Species included in these Appendices are referred to:
 - a) by the name of the species; or
 - b) as being all of the species included in a higher taxon or designated part thereof.
2. The abbreviation "sp." is used to denote all species of a higher taxon.
3. Other references to taxa higher than species are for the purposes of information or classification only.
4. The abbreviation "p.e." is used to denote species which are possibly extinct.
5. An asterisk (*) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon indicates that one or more geographically separate populations, subspecies or species of that species or taxon are included in Appendix I and that these populations, subspecies or species are excluded from Appendix II.
6. Two asterisks (**) placed against the name of a species or higher taxon indicates that one or more geographically separate populations, subspecies or species of that species or taxon are included in Appendix II and that these populations, subspecies or species are excluded from Appendix I.
7. The symbol (N) indicates that further details concerning that taxon may be found in the Notes on pages 30-33.
8. The symbol (P) indicates that details concerning further changes in the listing of that taxon may be found in the Special Flora Notes on pages 33-34.

- d) fruits and parts and derivatives thereof of naturalized or artificially propagated Cactaceae
- e) separate stem joints (pads) and parts and derivatives thereof of naturalized or artificially propagated *Opuntia* spp. subgenus *Opuntia*
- f) separate leaves and parts and derivatives thereof of naturalized or artificially propagated *Aloe vera*
- g) cut flowers of artificially propagated Orchidaceae
- h) fruits and parts and derivatives thereof of artificially propagated *Vanilla* spp.

Prior to 1 August 1985 all parts and derivatives of flora listed in Appendix II of the Convention were subject to CITES controls except where specifically designated as including only roots, trunks or timber.

This has resulted in the following changes:

 - Appendix II cactus species included only those whose wild populations were completely confined to the Americas. Therefore, with the exception of *Rhipsalis* spp. which was separately listed, all species with naturalized populations outside the Americas were not covered by CITES controls.
- On the basis of these interpretations of the annotation, its deletion resulted in one of the following four additions to Appendix II with respect to which Austria has entered a reservation:
- None; or
 - All cacti artificially propagated outside the Americas and from naturalized populations outside the Americas, except *Rhipsalis* spp. and species already in Appendix I; or
 - All naturalized populations of Appendix II cacti outside the Americas except those of *Rhipsalis* spp.; or
 - All species of cactus that have naturalized populations outside the Americas except *Rhipsalis* spp. and those listed in Appendix I.
