East Montgomery is a very fine school and one that anyone should be proud to attend. The atmosphere, surroundings, and student enthusiasm have made this school one of high quality and character.

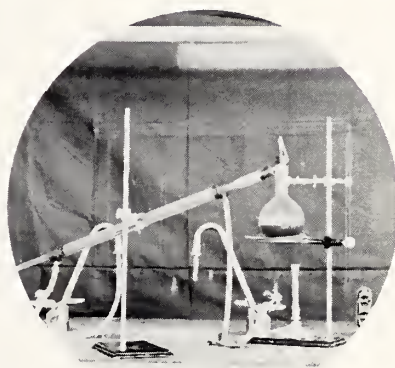
It is our hope that the students of the years following will uphold and grow with the true character of East. It is our wish that they will enjoy the fond memories and the deep influence that we have felt.

More than five-hundred new books have been purchased for the East Montgomery High School library. The books are from all classifications — fiction, history, science, social science, literature, and travel. These books are suited to all readers and all classes or departments.

Among the more valuable books are The American Heritage Book of **The Pioneer Spirit**, a book of pictures and reading material giving the story of pioneers from early America to the Space Age, a four-volume set of **The World of Mathematics**, a small library of the literature of mathematics from A "h-Mose" the Scribe, to Albert Einstein; **Life's The Worlds Great Religions**, picturing and explaining the ways men worshiped from Hinduism to the Christian era; **Margaret Mead's People and Places**; **Life's Wonders of Life on Earth**; **Roy Gallant's Man's Reach Into Space**.

Some of the new reference books are **The Worldmark Encyclopedia of the Nations**; **The Encyclopedia of Sports**; **Atlas of World History**; **Dictionary of Scientific Terms**; **The Encyclopedia of Child Care and Guidance**; **International World Atlas**; **The Global Atlas**.

Fiction titles included **My Antonia** by Willa Cather; **Mark Twain books**; **Prairie** by James Fenimore Cooper; **Vein Of Iron** by Ellen Glasgow; **Ugly American** by Lederer; **How Green Was My Valley** by Llewellyn; **Paton's Cry Beloved Country**. Hemingway's short stories of Mark Twain books were also purchased.

nor, has been developing rapidly in the past few weeks. One of the most interesting phases of the department is the French class. The school has given the language class two tape recorders which the students are finding amusing, helpful, and necessary. To learn French, it is vital that one be able to pronounce words as nearly correct as possible. The new recorders are helpful in this field of learning.

The department also has eight earphones. With these, the students can hear a sentence pronounced correctly and then repeat it. There are thirty-two different tapes which the students may hear. These tapes have books to follow up the recordings.

The department has just received a new Bell and Howell tape recorder. This unique recorder is useful because one is able to hear and record on the same tape. Many French records have been given to the class also.

The students now have a variety of facilities in their classes, a variety which makes studying French more interesting.

Parents Attend Classes

Parents attending the P. T. A. on Thursday November 16, followed the schedules of a regular school day and visited the classrooms of their children. Members of the Future Teachers' Club and other students acted as guides and directed the parents into the classrooms for a ten minute period.
