We sincerely hope that as time carries our most precious moments into the past, this edition of the AQUILA will serve to recapture these moments and to help us relive them as if they were happening once again.

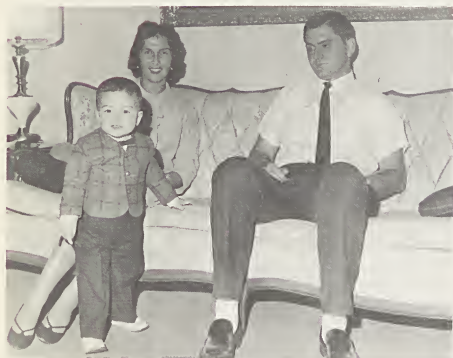

SUGGESTIONS FOR LEARNING PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE



1. Practice periods should not be longer than ten minutes unless active interest in the program is in evidence.

SUGGESTIONS FOR FFA MEMBERS



1. There can be but one main motion before the chapter at a time.

3. However, withdrawal of a motion is not in order.
4. The terms president, presiding officer, chair, and chairman are used interchangeably. If the presiding officer is to be addressed, he should be addressed as "Mr. President" or "Mr. Chairman" as correct.
5. However, for any presiding officer, except when a lady is presiding in the case of the National FFA Council, or "Madam Chairman" or "Madam President" is correct.
6. Members should write and bring motions and resolutions to the secretary in advance if possible.
7. A copy of the minutes of the chapter should be sent to the secretary of the chapter.

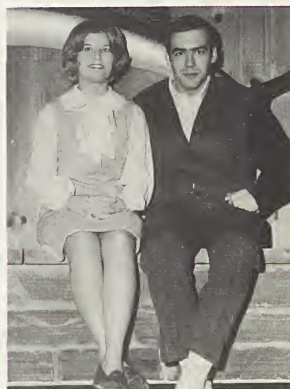

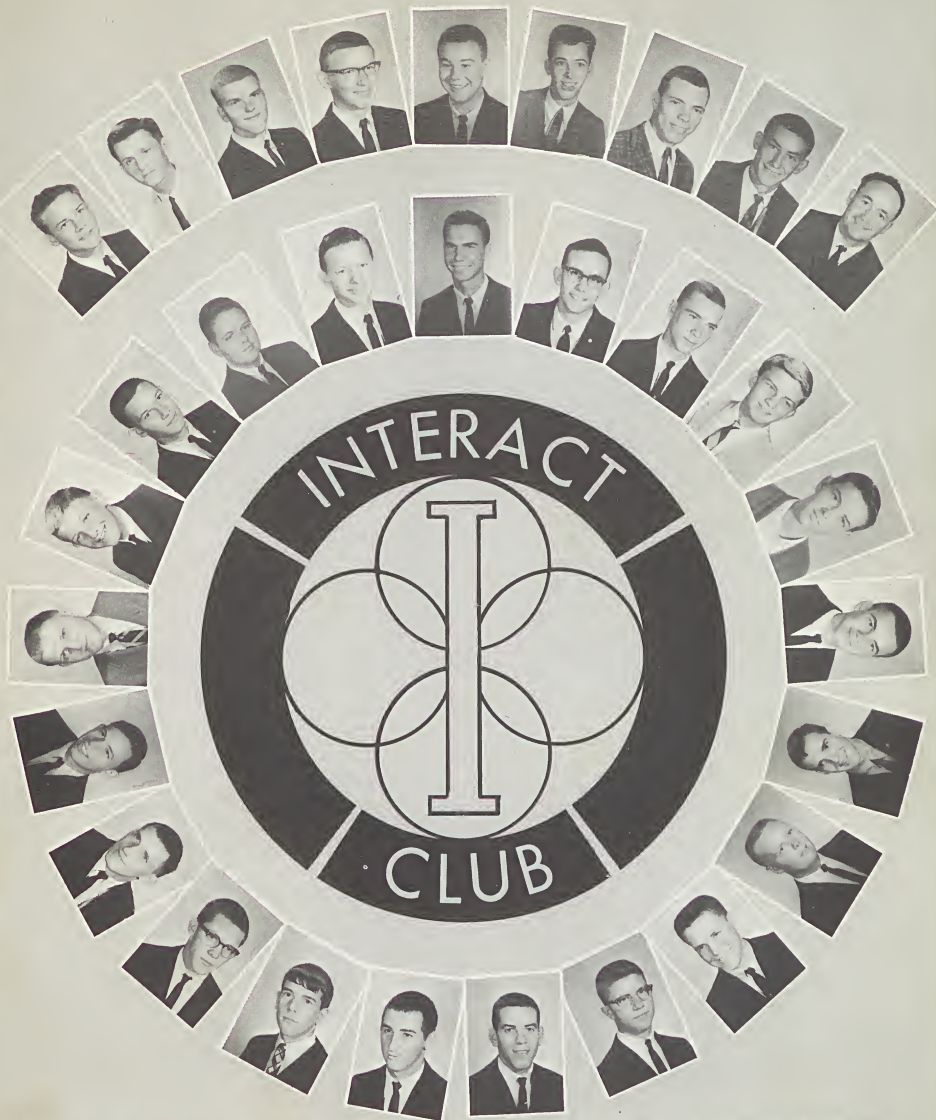

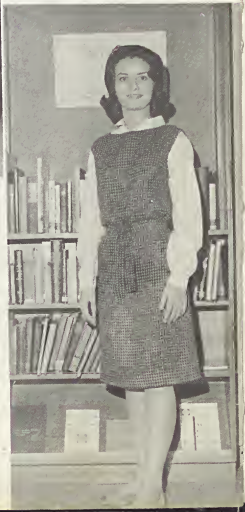

Published seven times yearly, the East Wind brings to focus every phase of student activity through school news articles and feature stories.

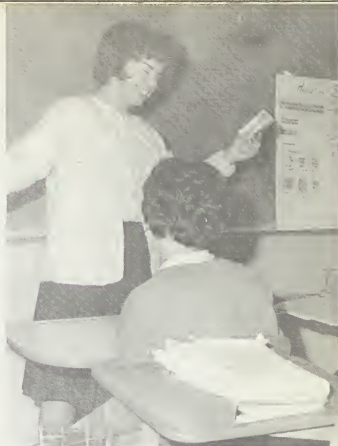
