us here.

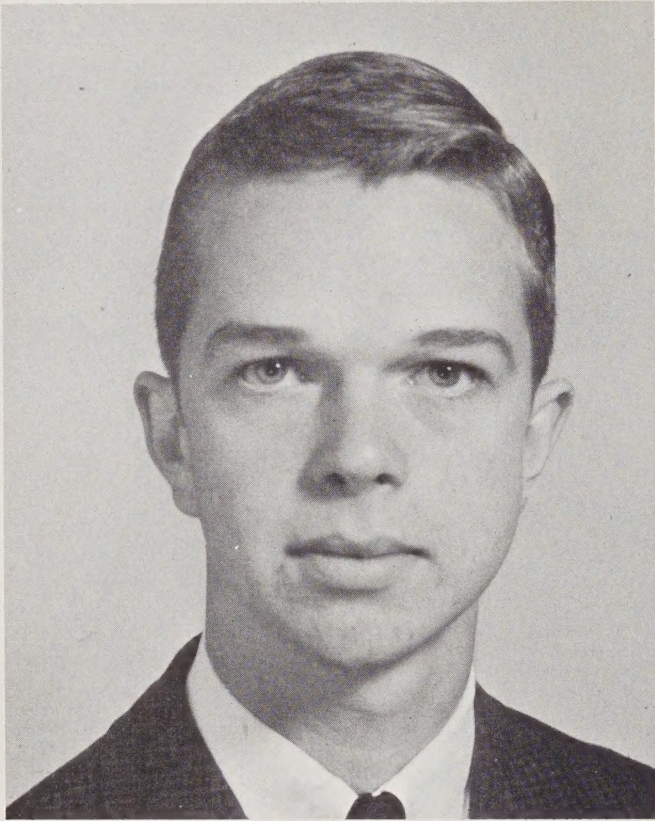

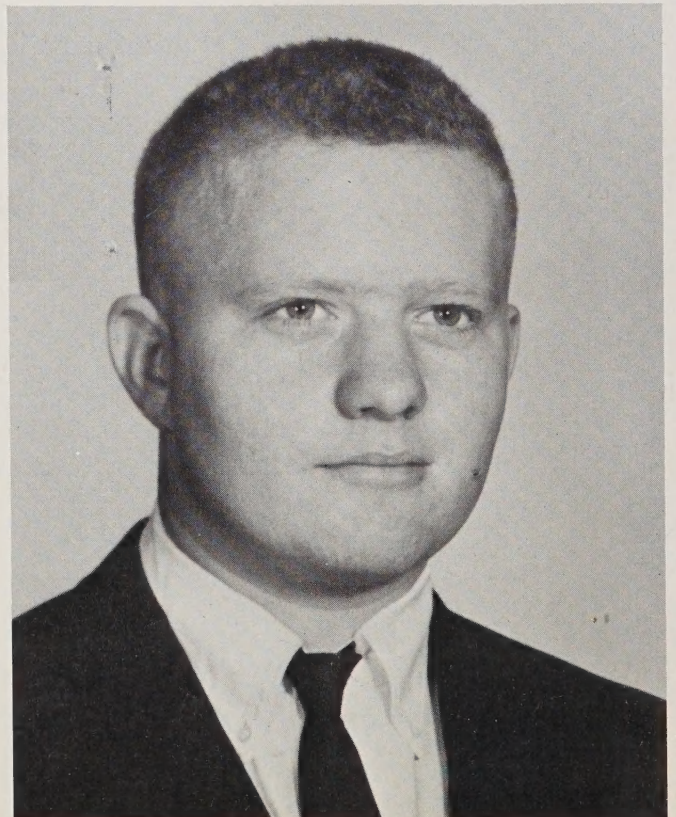

Or but subserves another's gain.

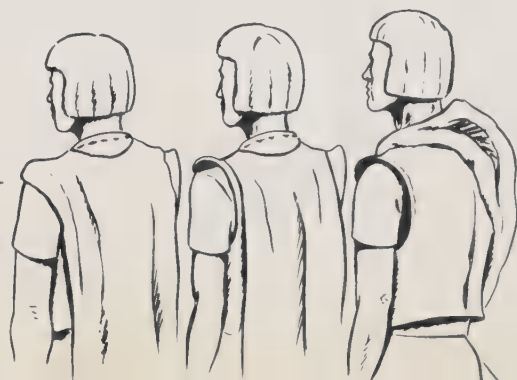
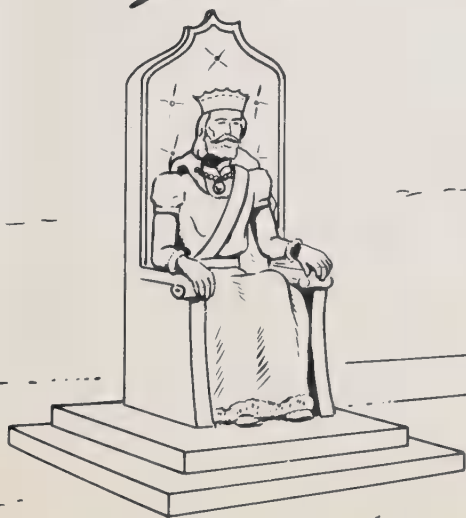
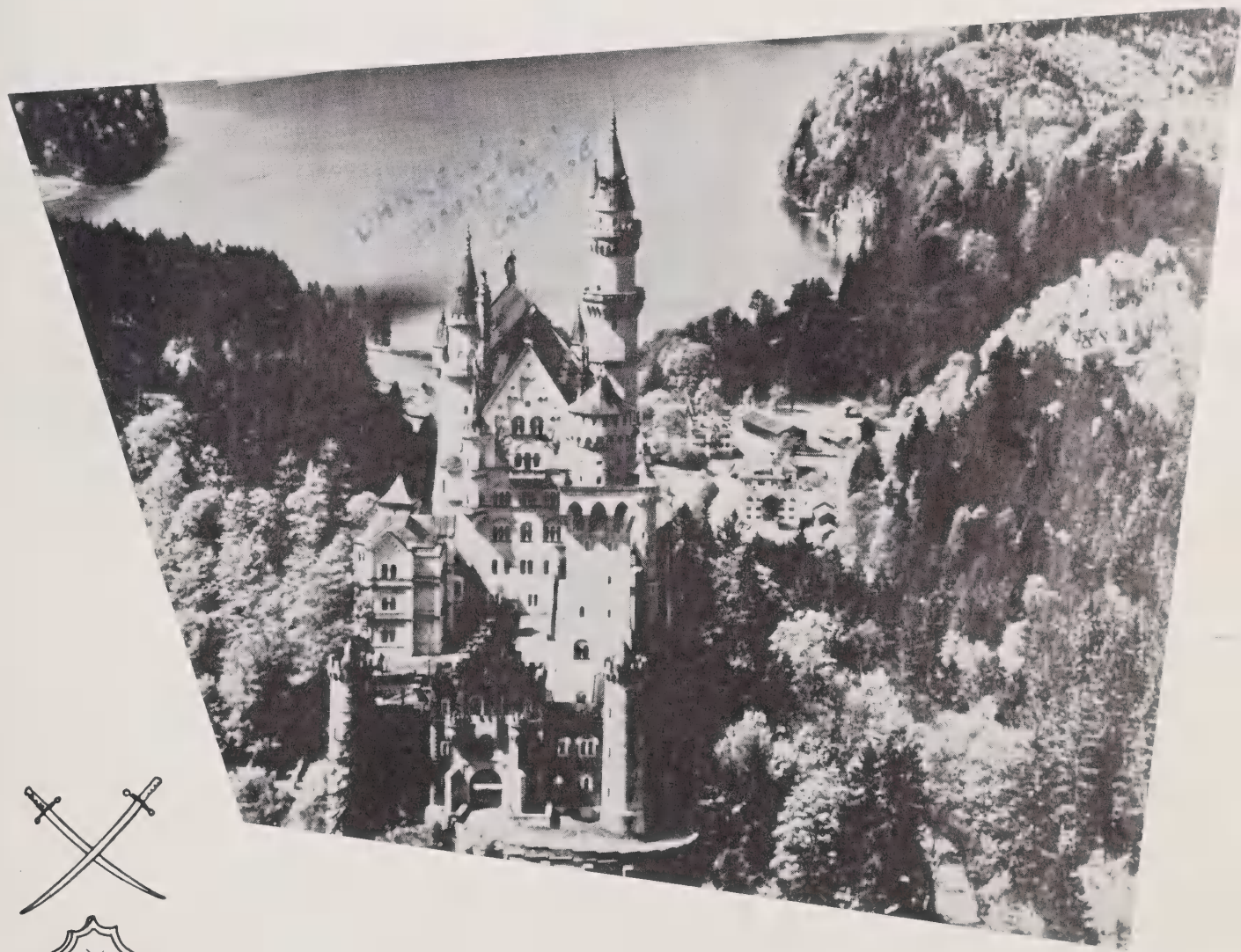
