



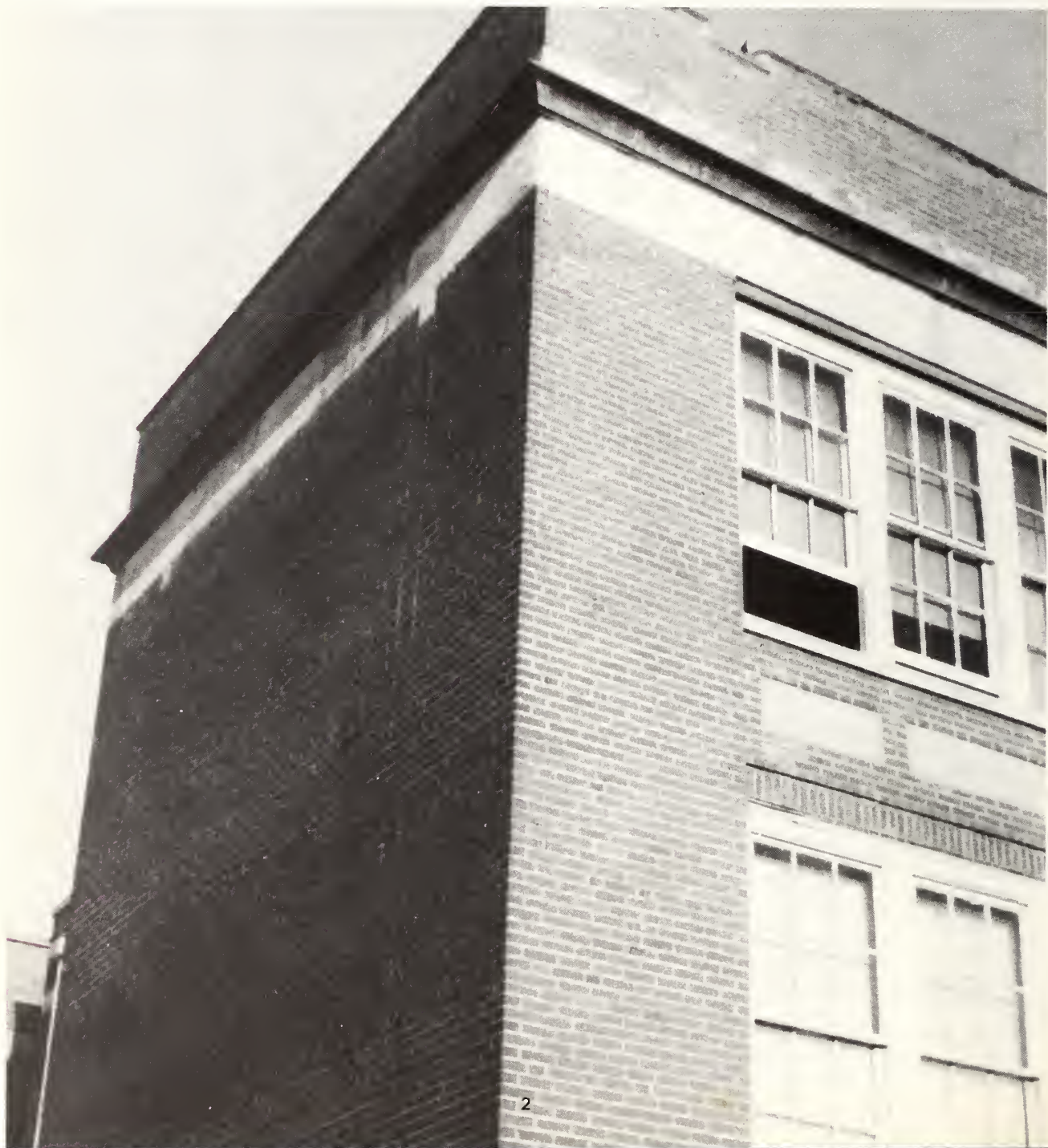

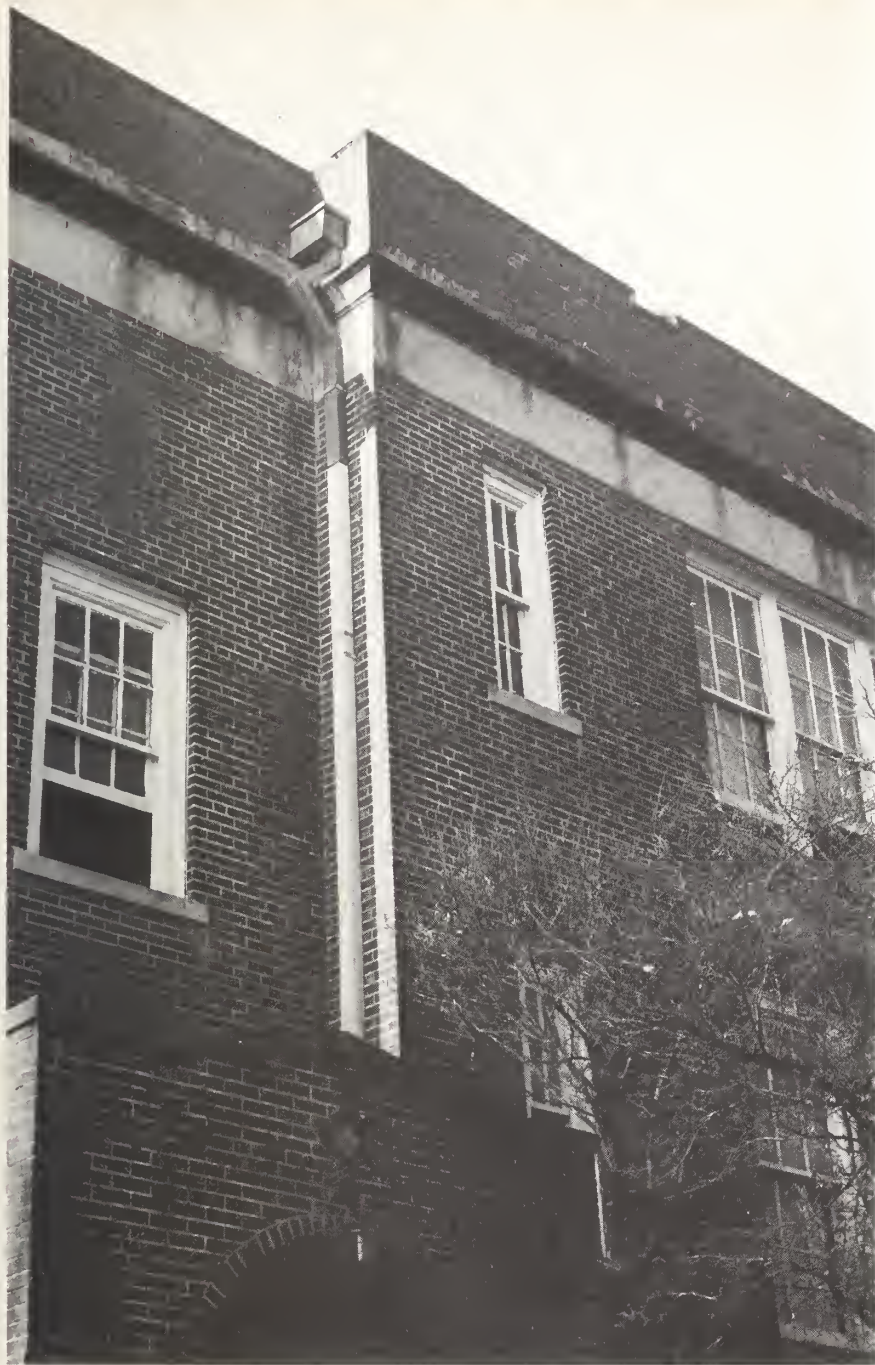
The shades of night were falling fast,

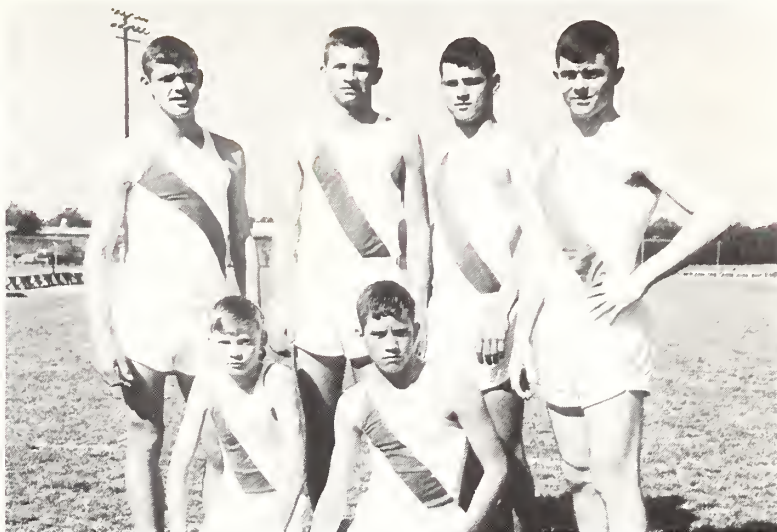

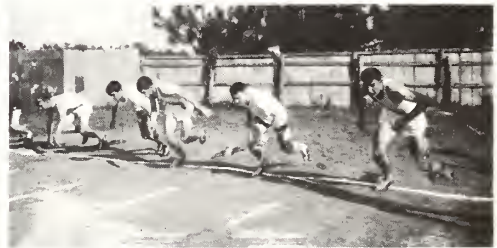
