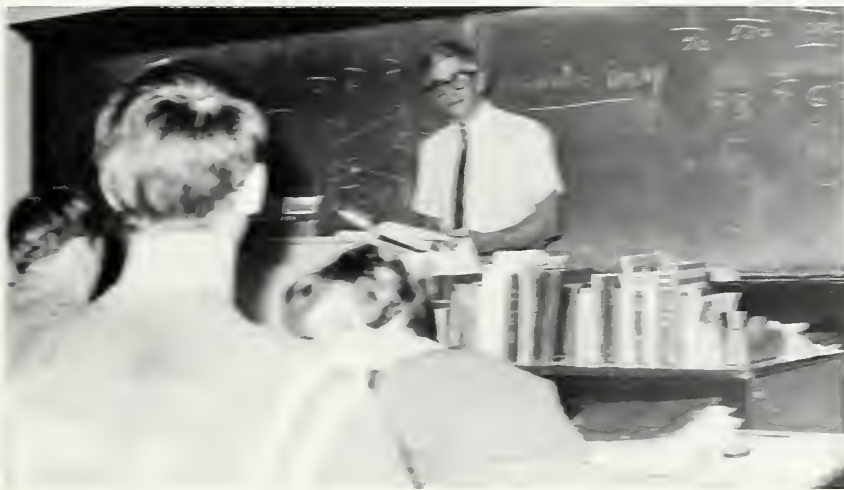

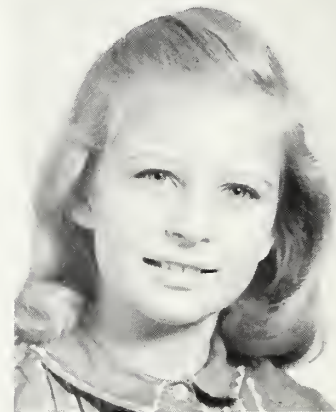
# In Remembrance . . .
