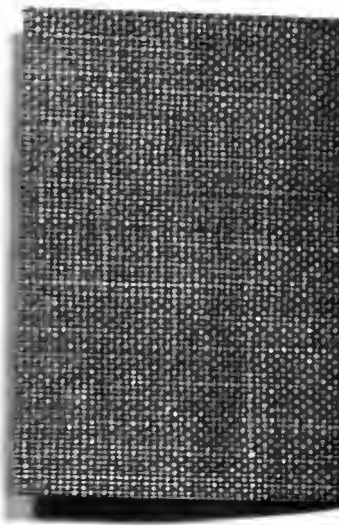

POST OFFICE INFORMATION.

RATES OF POSTAGE.
 To and from all parts of the United Kingdom, for prepaid letters—
 Not exceeding 4 oz. 1d.
 Exceed 4 oz. but not excd. 8 oz. 2d.
 " 6 oz. " 8 oz. 2d.
 " 8 oz. " 10 oz. 3d.
 and so on, one halfpenny additional for every two ounces. Letters not prepaid, or insufficiently prepaid, are charged double on delivery.

INLAND PARCELS POST.
 Parcels not exceeding—
 1 lb. 3d. 7 lb. 9d.
 2 lb. 4d. 8 lb. 10d.
 3 lb. 5d. 9 lb. 11d.
 4 lb. 6d. 10 lb. 1s.
 5 lb. 7d. 11 lb. 1s. 1d.
 6 lb. 8d.

Postage must be prepaid.

POST OFFICE ORDERS.
 Money Orders are granted in the United Kingdom as follows:—
 Not exceeding £1. 3d.
 " £3. 3d.
 " £10. 4d.

BOOK AND CIRCULAR POST.
 The postage is 4d. per 2 oz. or fraction thereof. Unpaid postage, double rates on delivery. Paskets must be open at the ends, or in open covers. Above 2 oz. Letter Postage rate.

POSTAGE ON INLAND REGISTERED NEWSPAPERS.
PREPAID RATES.—For each registered newspaper, whether posted singly or in a packet—one halfpenny; but a packet containing two or more registered newspapers is not chargeable with a higher rate of postage than would be chargeable on a book-packet of the same weight.

POSTAL ORDERS.
 Postal Orders are now issued at any Money Order Office. They are charged thus:—1/ or 1s. 3d.
 2/ 2s. 3/ 3s. 4/ 4s. 5/ 5s. 7/ 7s. 10/ 10s. 1d. 1s. 15/ or 20/ 13d.
 Postal Orders are not payable at Post Offices abroad.

REGISTRATION.
 By a fee of twopence, any letter, newspaper or book-packet may be registered to any place in the United Kingdom or the British Colonies.
