12. To create and nurture a love of country life.

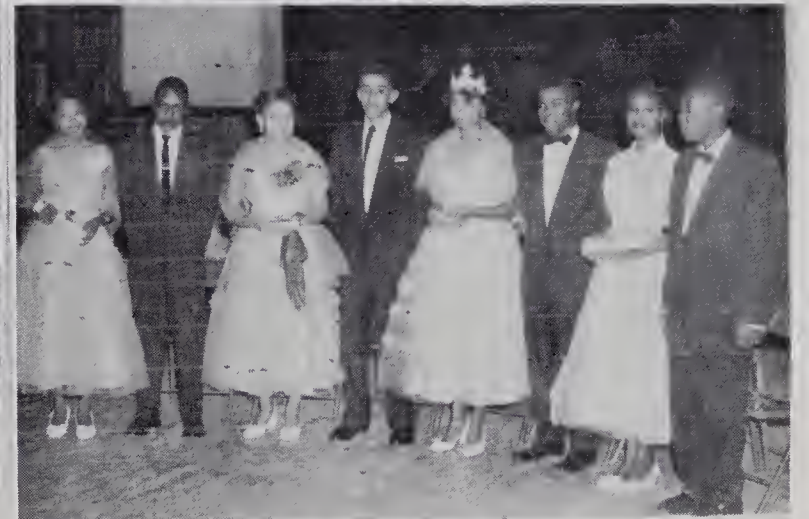
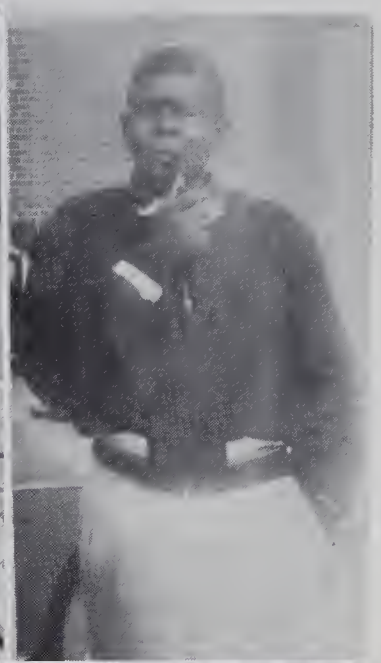
