COA CHORALE

The COA Chorale is open to both students and faculty members from COA. The purpose of the chorale is to learn and to perform, often in conjunction with the Albemarle Corale Society, pieces selected from various eras of musical

composition.

This year's emphasis has been placed on 18th, 19th, and 20th century music performed in America in a series of Bicentennial Concerts. Concerts were composed of works from J.S. Bach, G.F. Handel, William Billings, and various Moravian composers from the 18th century. A short cantata on the Burr Conspiracy, a group of songs by Stephen Foster, some Post-Bellum Negro spirituals and parts of the first Broadway musical from the 19th and 20th century, some college Ragtime-Showtime songs and choruses plus a few contemporary Pops compositions based on patriotism.
