





TRIBUTE



Mr. Eugene M. Howell

Mr. Eugene M. Howell has been a mainstay of Shaw University since 1925. He was employed under the administration of Dr. W. Nelson and has maintained his employment since that time. "When I first came here," said Mr. Howell, "Tupper Hall was the gymnasium. The young men lived in Shaw Hall in which a portion was divided into a bookstore." The physical appearance of the campus has changed tremendously since that time. Thick bushes dominated the grounds, and the place where the mobile units are located was a garden. Since he was the only maintenance man employed by Shaw at that time, Mr. Howell assumed the responsibility of cutting down most of the bushes and plowing the entire campus grounds. So great were his other duties that it took him two weeks to mow the entire lawn.

The upkeep of the campus, then and now, is not the only contribution Mr. Howell has made to this institution. He has successfully integrated himself into the Shaw family by sending four of his daughters here — three having graduated and now holding teaching positions. They are Annie R. Howell, who teaches in Snow Hill, North Carolina; the former Senora Howell, who teaches in Seaboard, North Carolina; and the former Lula Howell, who teaches in Louisburg, North Carolina.

Words cannot express our appreciation of Mr. Howell. He has well exemplified the spirit of Shaw University by rendering unselfish service for the betterment of our college community.
