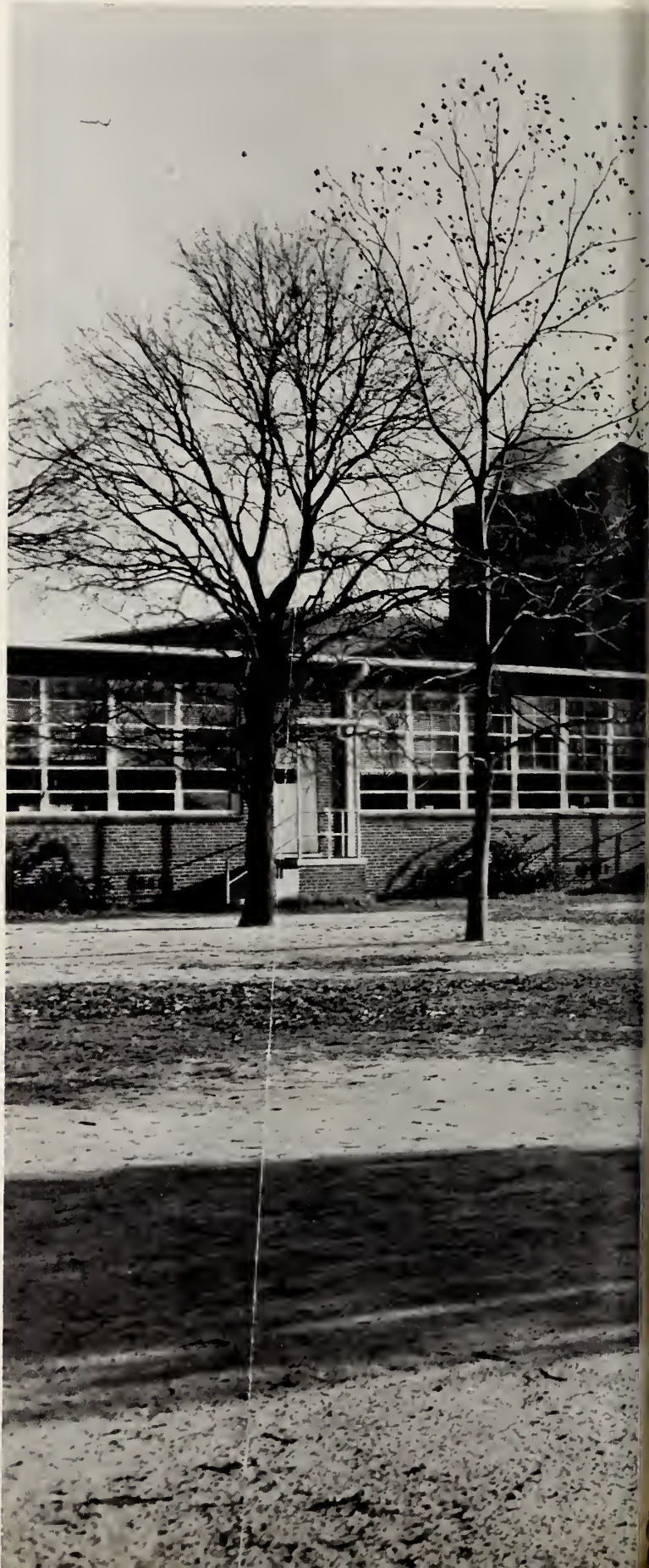
## *Around Elm City High in 180 Days*
