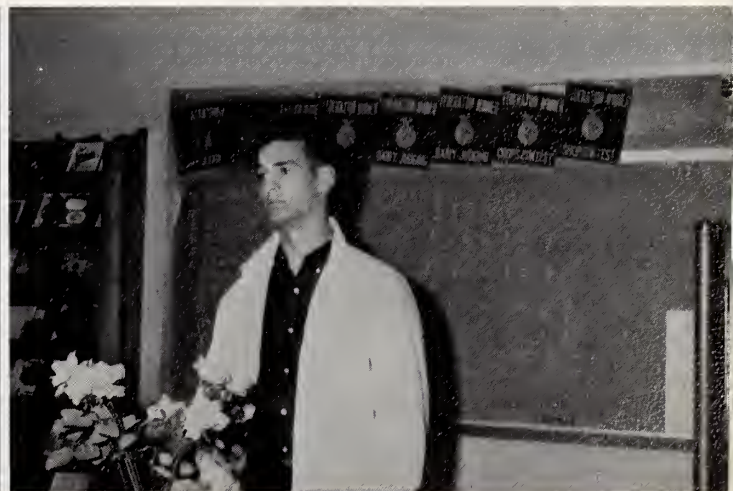
## *Future Farmers of America*
