# Dedication



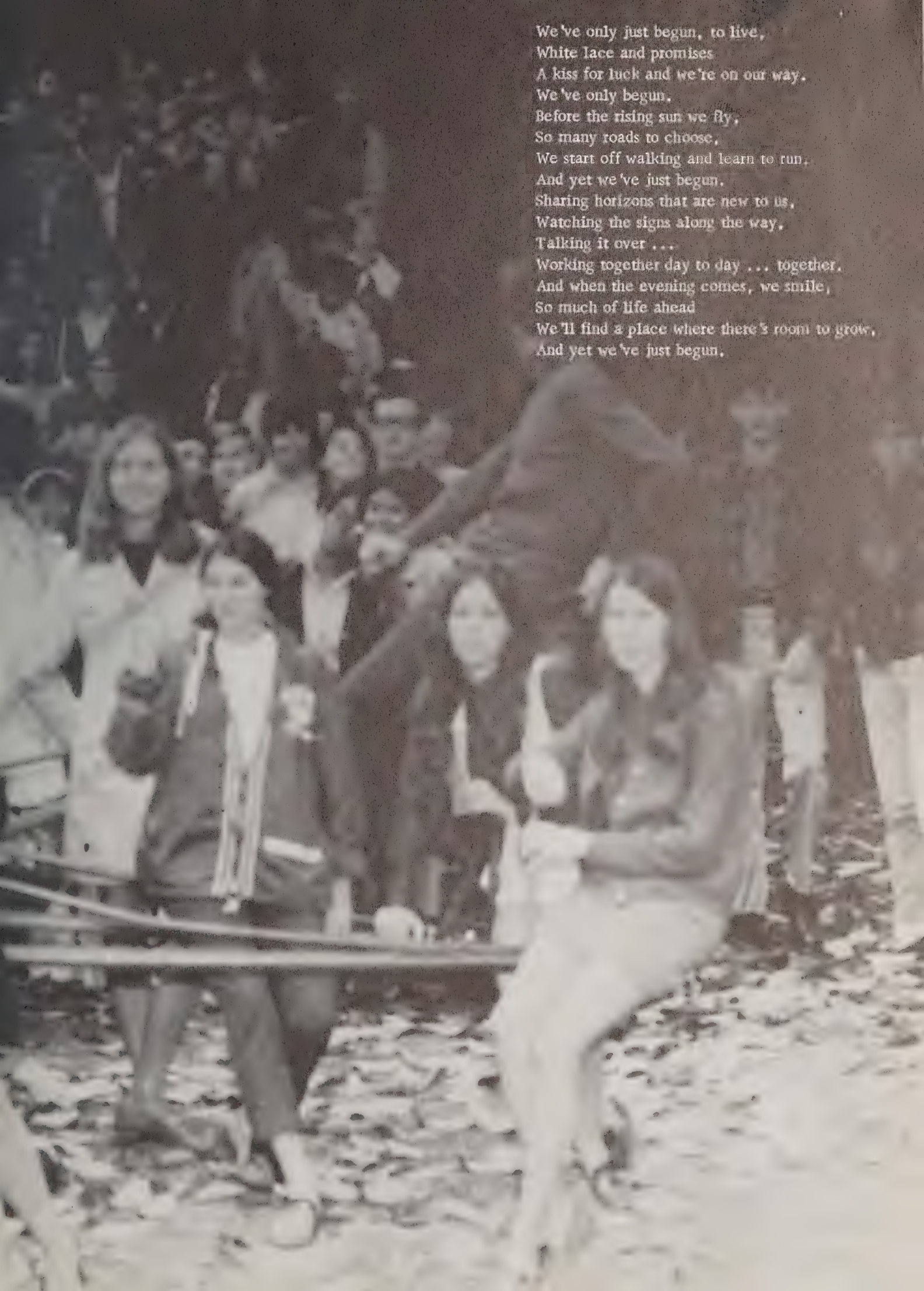
