

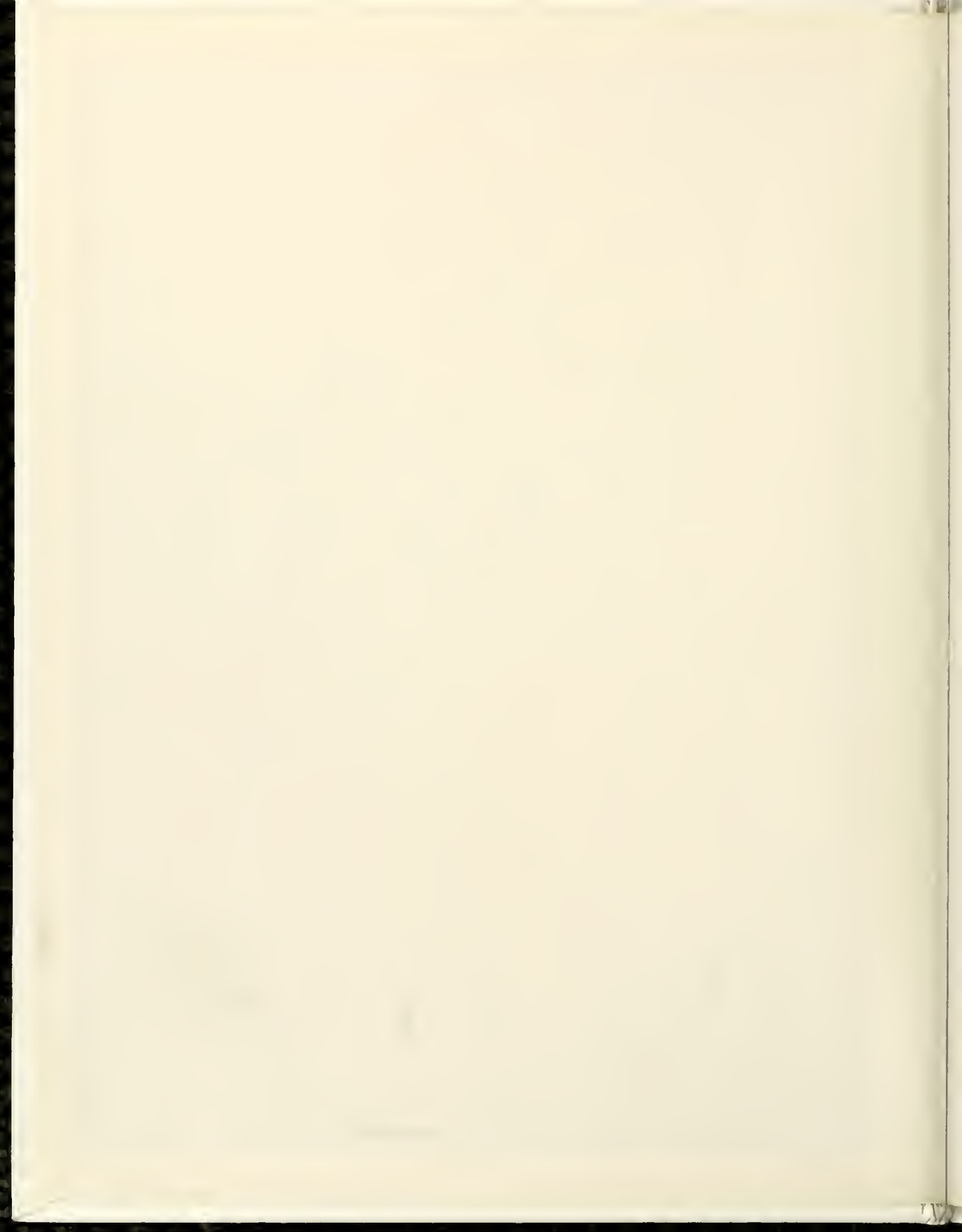


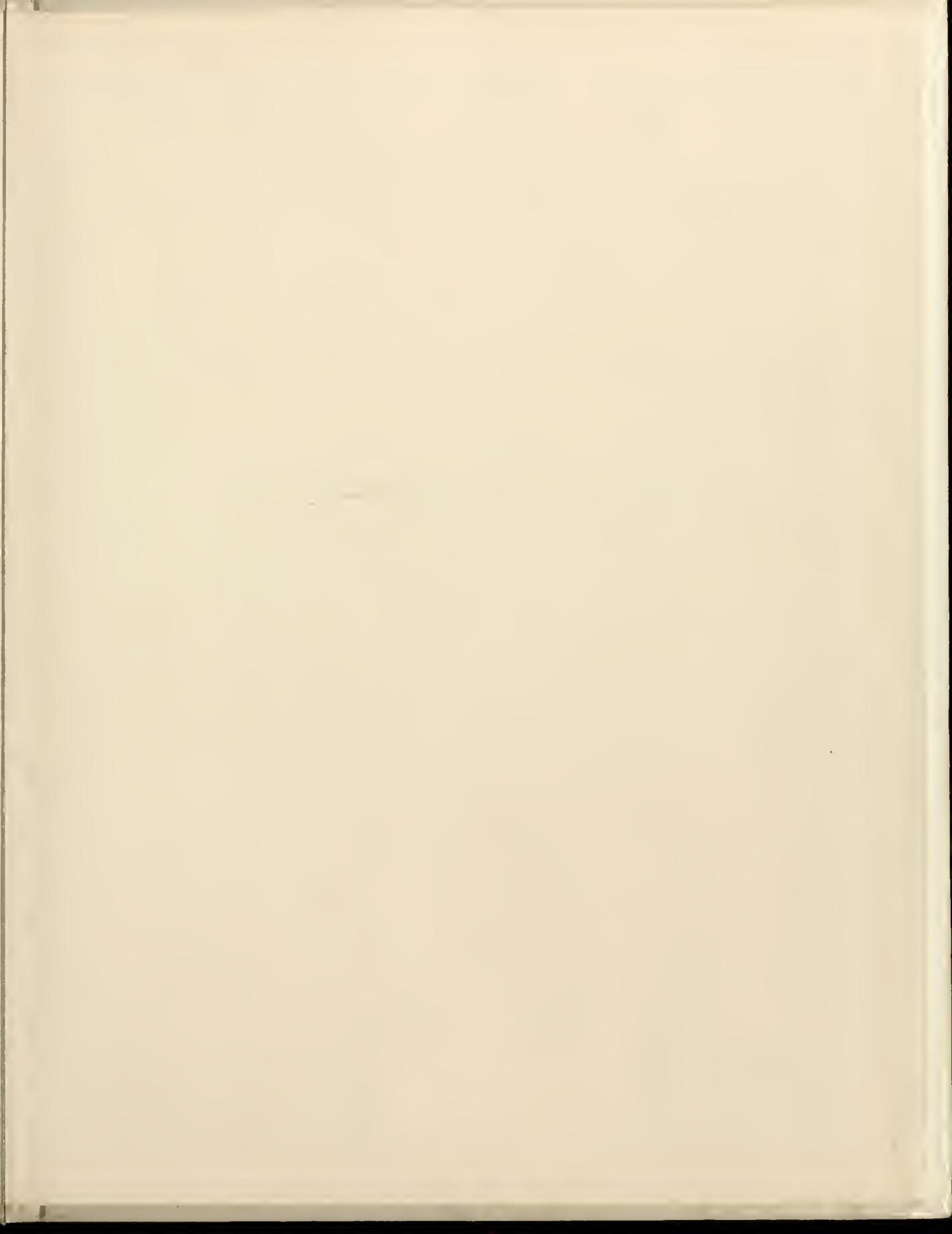

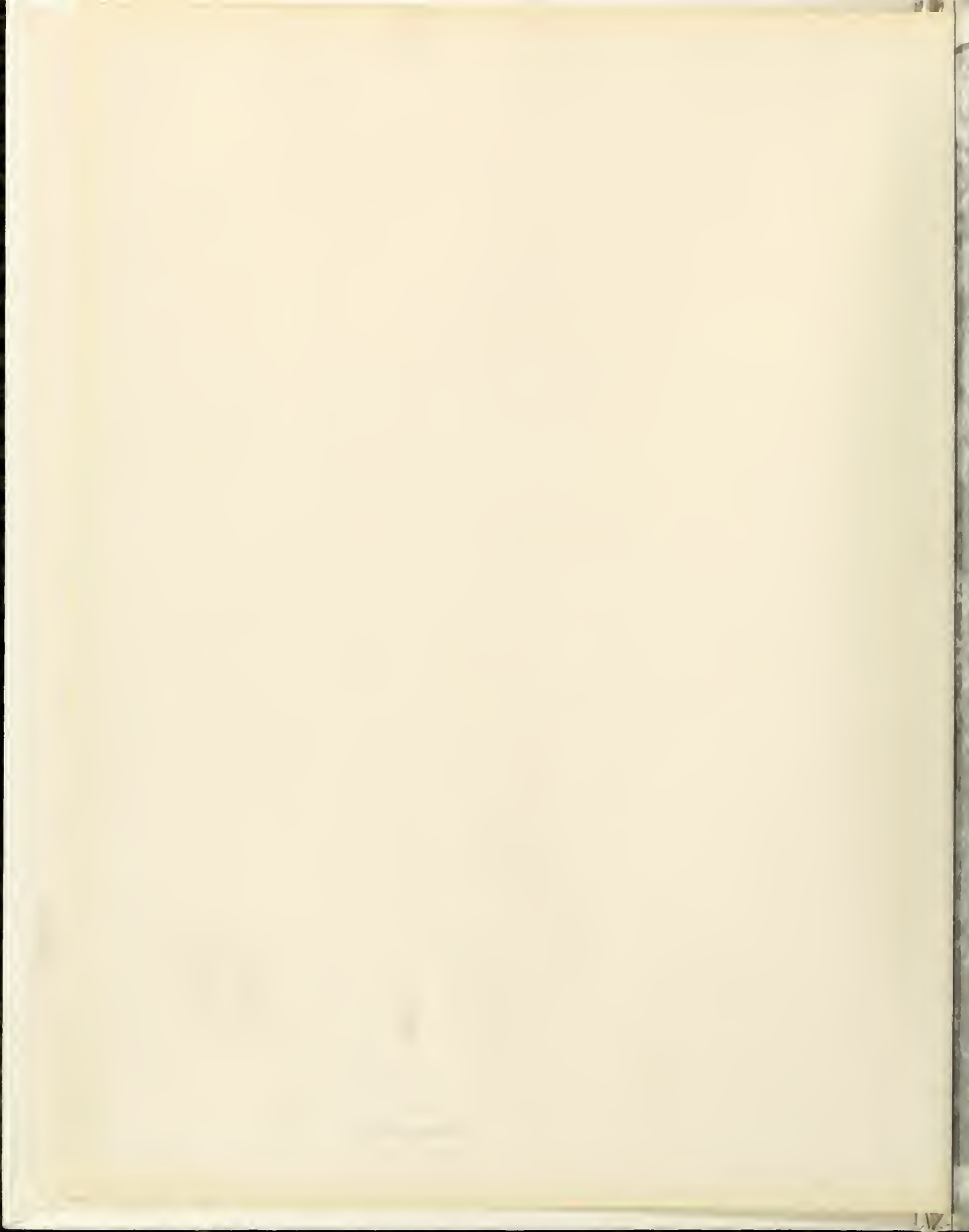

The purpose of Bennett College is to maintain distinction as an institution of higher learning by offering women an education conducive to excellence in scholarly pursuits, preparation for leadership roles, and life-long learning in a contemporary society. The College offers selected education, training, and research experiences, appropriate for preparation in the arts and sciences, the professions, and for public service. Consistent with its church-related heritage, Bennett college nurtures the development of spiritual and moral values to undergird educational, scientific and technological endeavors. The College advances cognizance of African-American heritage, international awareness, and the preparation of world citizens.

In the implementation of its purpose and educational goals, Bennett College seeks to bring together a cosmopolitan administration, faculty and staff that endorse the nature and purpose of a liberal arts college for women, and whose scholarship, skills and values are supportive of the mission of the College. Overall, excellence in performance is valued as the foundation for the achievement of mission and educational goals and is the primary emphasis in all teaching and learning endeavors at Bennett College.

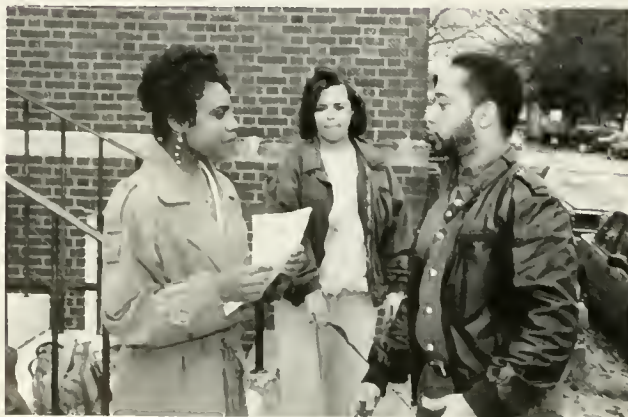

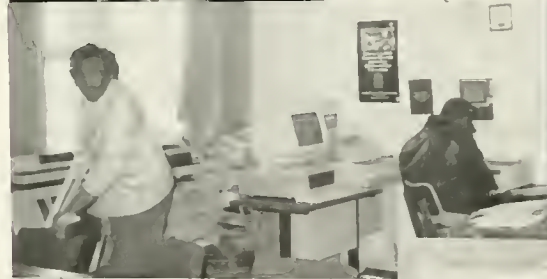

Darlene Marie Ayres-Lynch was born in Gary, Indiana, on October 3, 1952. She received her elementary and secondary education in the Gary Public Schools System. She was a graduate of Roosevelt High School, Class of 1970. During her junior year of college, she studied Spanish at the University of Madrid in Madrid, Spain. She graduated from Defiance College in Defiance, Ohio, in 1973, and received her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Spanish, and received her Master of Arts Degree from Indiana University of Pennsylvania in College Student Personnel.

Darlene was previously employed as Director of Financial Aid at Millersville State College, Millersville, Pennsylvania; University of Minnesota, St. Paul, Minnesota; and Bennet College, Greensboro, North Carolina. Her professional organizations included the State-Regional-National Student Financial Aid Professional Organization, for which she was program chairman on the national level; executive board member of Summit Team Center, St. Paul, Minnesota; and a member of the Lupus Foundation. She was a member of the Pilgrim Baptist Church, St. Paul, Minnesota.

Her family members consisted of: a husband, Mr. Vincent Lynch of Greensboro, North Carolina; parents, John T. and Anna Ayres of Gary, Indiana; and others. Although she was not at Bennett very long, she left behind many fond memories. Darlene Marie Ayres-Lynch joined "another life" on Sunday, July 21, 1991, at Duke Hospital, Durham, North Carolina, after a brief illness.

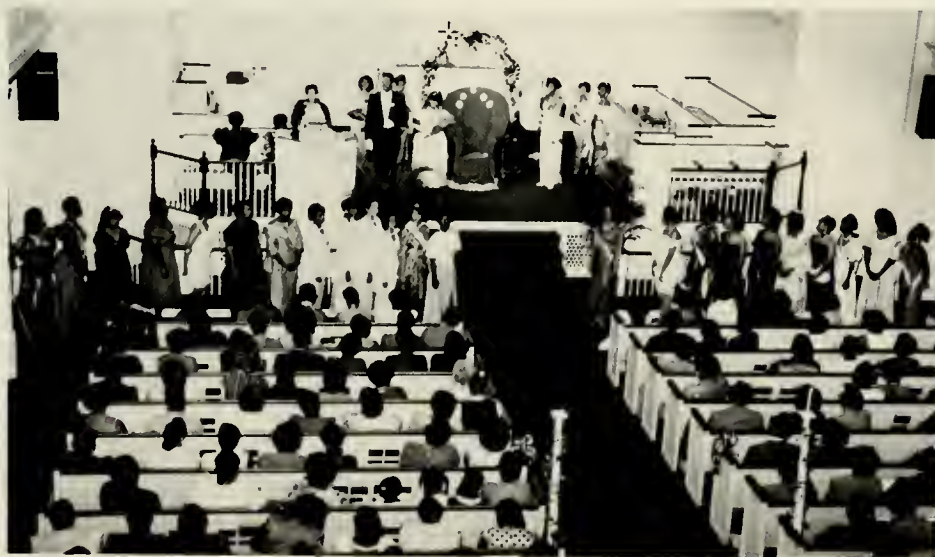

I Am Me

My Declaration Of Self-Esteem

In all the world, there is no one else exactly like me. 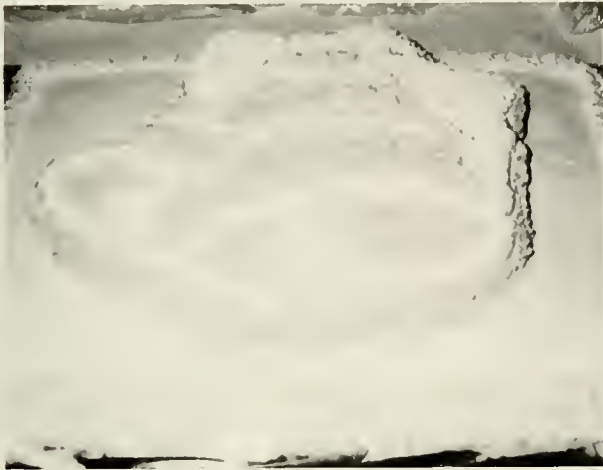

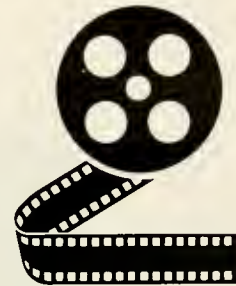

ACADEMIC CULTURAL ENRICHMENT SERIES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Academic Cultural Enrichment Series program is to enhance the cultural, spiritual, and educational life of the college. Programs will be offered in three areas: (1) worship services, (2) convocations/lectures, and (3) performing arts.

PROCEDURES

Registration forms will be issued to each student at the start of the scheduled event (indicating their name, social security number and date of event). Only one registration form should be accepted per student. Students must report on time. No registration forms will be issued beyond a fifteen minute time period after the event has started.

ACES registration forms are to be turned in at the end of each event to the appropriate monitors (faculty/staff/marshal) who will be stationed at the event location exits. Only one registration form will be accepted per student. No credit will be given to any student who does not abide by these procedures.

ATTENDANCE

Each student must attend seventy five (75)% of the ACES programs scheduled in any given semester. Attendance will be kept by registration form only. Each student must take care to see that she is registered for events to which she is in attendance. The ACES attendance requirement is applicable to all full time students. ACES attendance is a requirement for all eight semesters of matriculation at Bennett College.

ATTIRE

Chapel attire shall be dresses and skirts. No pants or shorts will be allowed as attire for Chapel ACES.

CONFLICTS

If there are any circumstances which may prevent a student from attaining the 75% quota of program attendance for a given semester, she must apply for an attendance waiver to the Office of the Dean of Student Life at the beginning of the semester (first six weeks).

Students who receive ACES waivers will be responsible for attending at least five (5) ACES programs. Failure to complete this requirement will result in a "U" grade. Extenuating circumstances preventing compliance with the regulation must be presented to the Dean of Student Life.

CREDIT-GRADES

Grades will be "S" Satisfactory or "U" Unsatisfactory. Those students attending 75%, or more, of the programs during the semester will receive a grade of "S" and those not meeting this requirement during the semester will receive a grade of "U". For persons receiving waivers, a no credit grade will be recorded and penalties will not be applicable.

ACES CONTINGENCIES

- 1 Academic honors may not be received with "U" (unsatisfactory) ACES credit in the semester prior to eligibility.
- 2 Students will not be eligible to pledge membership in any national organization sanctioned by the College and the Student Government Association, if she has received a grade of "U" (unsatisfactory) in ACES the semester prior to her application.

ACES DESIGNATION

All programs and activities to be designated for credit in the ACES Series must be submitted to the ACES Committee through the Chairperson by April 1 for the Fall semester and October 1 for the spring semester.

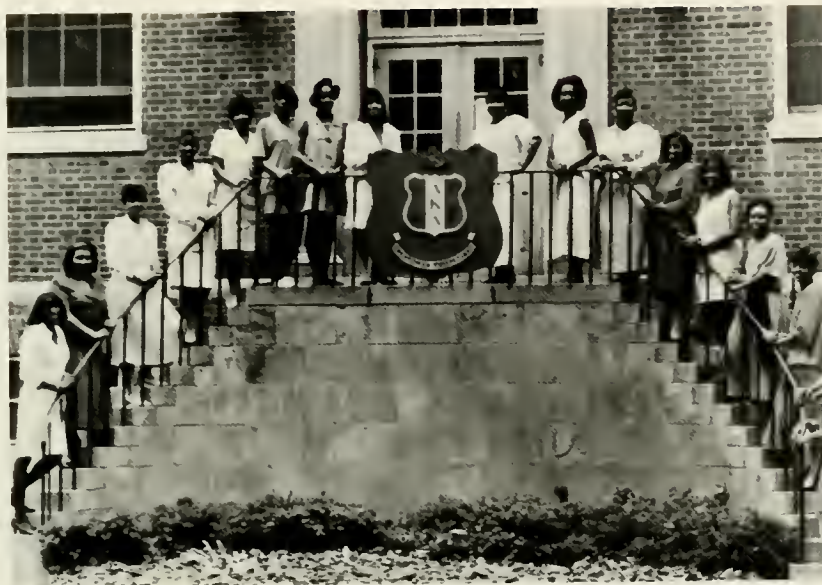

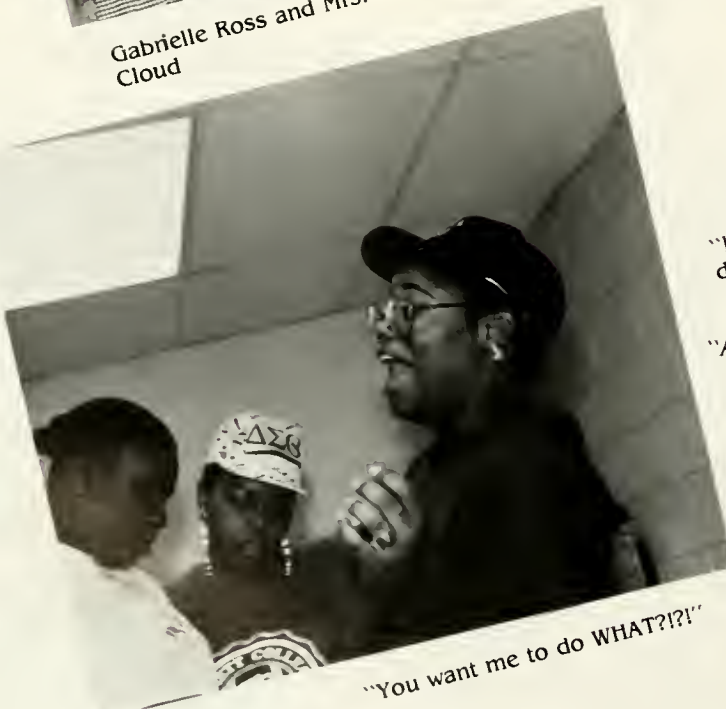

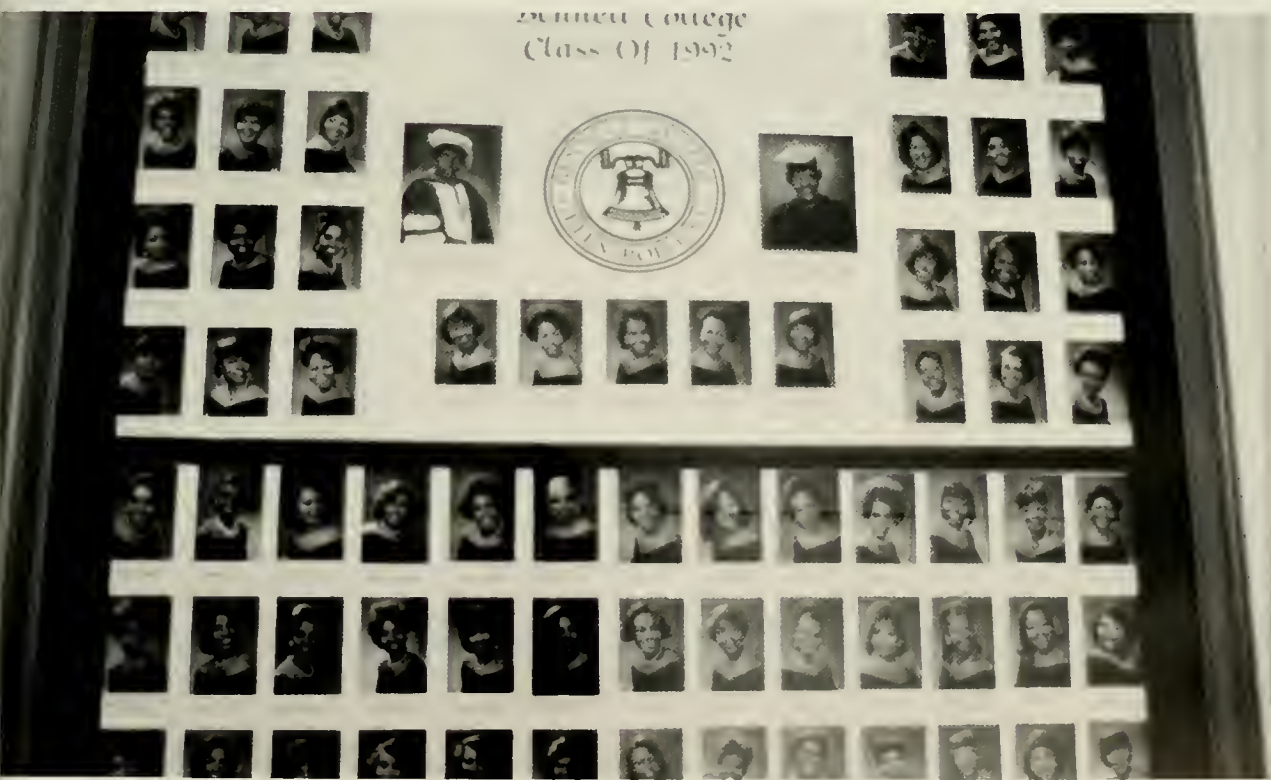
