

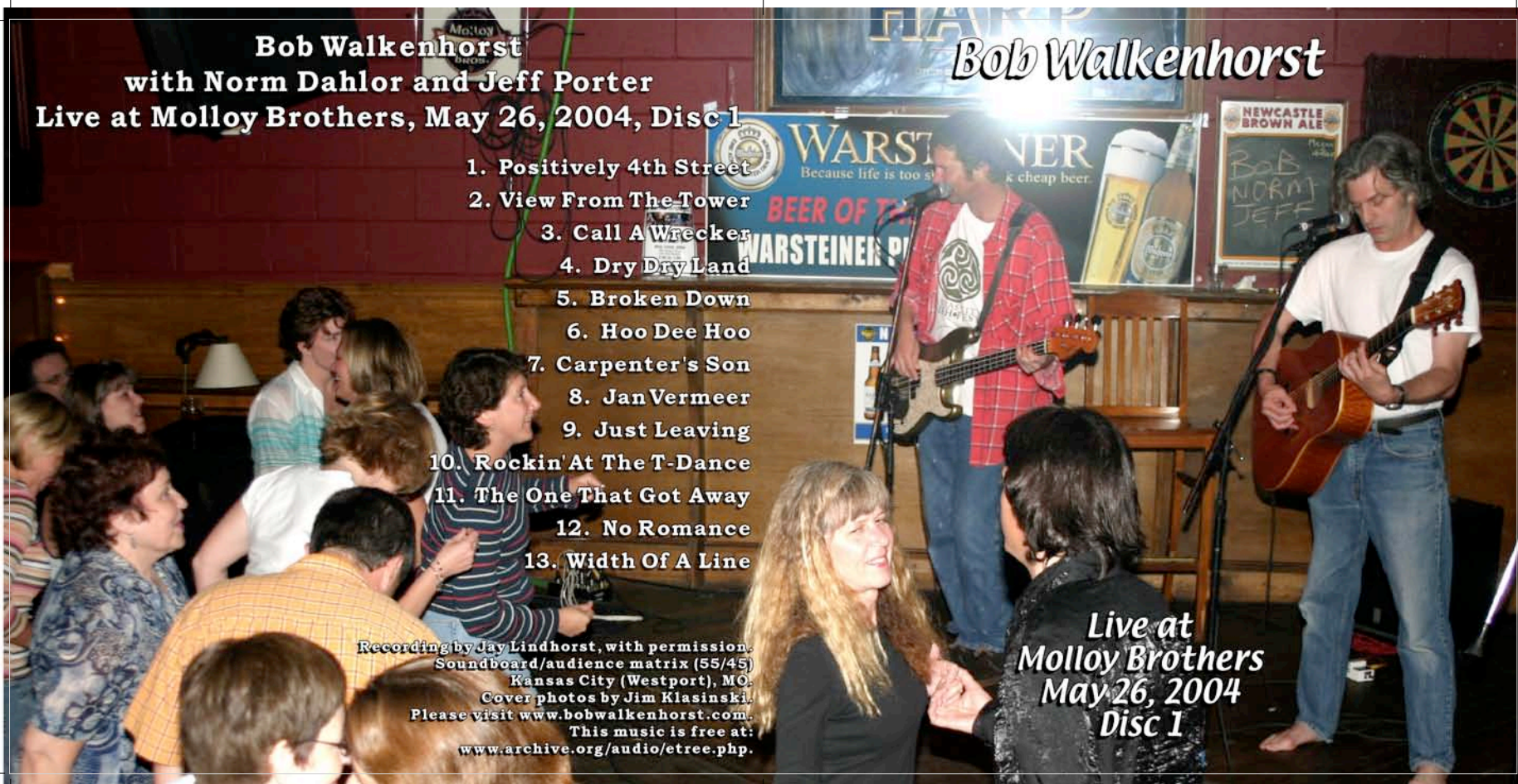



## **CD Covers for Jay's Recordings of Bob Walkenhorst at Molloy Brothers**

I construct these covers for my own use, and I make no claims to be a graphic artist. For those of you without the patience or software to compose your own CD covers, I hope these will suffice. I use slimline cases or paper envelopes, so I do not make "u-cards" (back covers for traditional gem cases) except on special occasions.

### **VIEWING AND PRINTING:**

These CD covers are in Adobe Acrobat portable document format (.pdf). You may view and print the covers on virtually any computing platform with Adobe Acrobat Reader, which is available for download free-of-charge from (<http://www.adobe.com>). If you have trouble opening or printing a file, check to make sure your version of Acrobat Reader is up-to-date.

For best results when printing the files, do **NOT** select "Shrink Oversized Pages to Paper Size" or "Enlarge Small Pages to Paper Size" in Acrobat printing options. If necessary, you can experiment with manually scaling the covers in the "advanced" settings of the "print" dialogue box.

The photos extend over the edges of the cut lines in order to help prevent white fringes.

Some early covers use photos are drawn from the videos for "Life Can Turn" and "Primitivo Garcia" that are included on Bob Walkenhorst's CD "The Beginner." The camera work is credited to Bill Pryor and Valerie Anderson. These images are used with blind faith that nobody will get mad.
