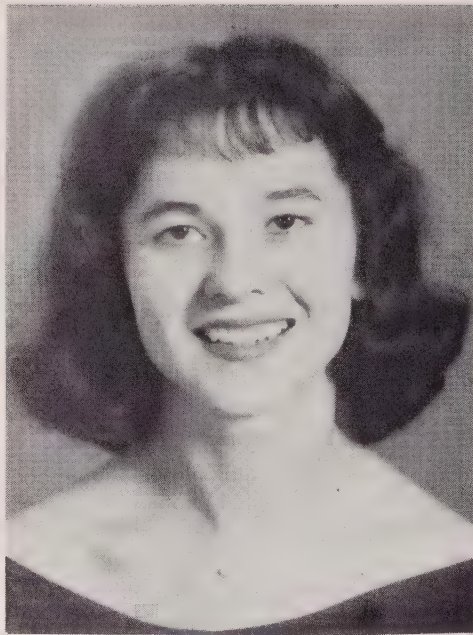
FRANCES ELLINGTON is a basketball coach for Dabney girls. She got that Robinson boy so she decided to coach for Dabney instead of Middleburg.
