I was present at the medical lectures of your college last ~~year~~ winter and took out my Matriculation ticket and those of the several Professors with the exception of yours which I regretted exceedingly. —

I was unable then to obtain your ticket though I took the liberty of attending your lectures from not having enough funds at the time but intended doing so later in the season. I was then prevented from acting as I wished as I was called home in a great hurry by the severe illness of my sister whom I am happy to say

has recovered almost by a miracle -

I intend going through another course of lectures next winter at your college and as it is the wish of my friends I should then graduate it is indispensable I should have your ticket for this session just past & the next one to come, since I believe it is the law of your Institute for every student to have gone through 2 full courses ere he can receive his diploma.
