Twenty-five lbs, or over, will be invoiced at the 100 lb. price, and one-half bushel at the bushel price.

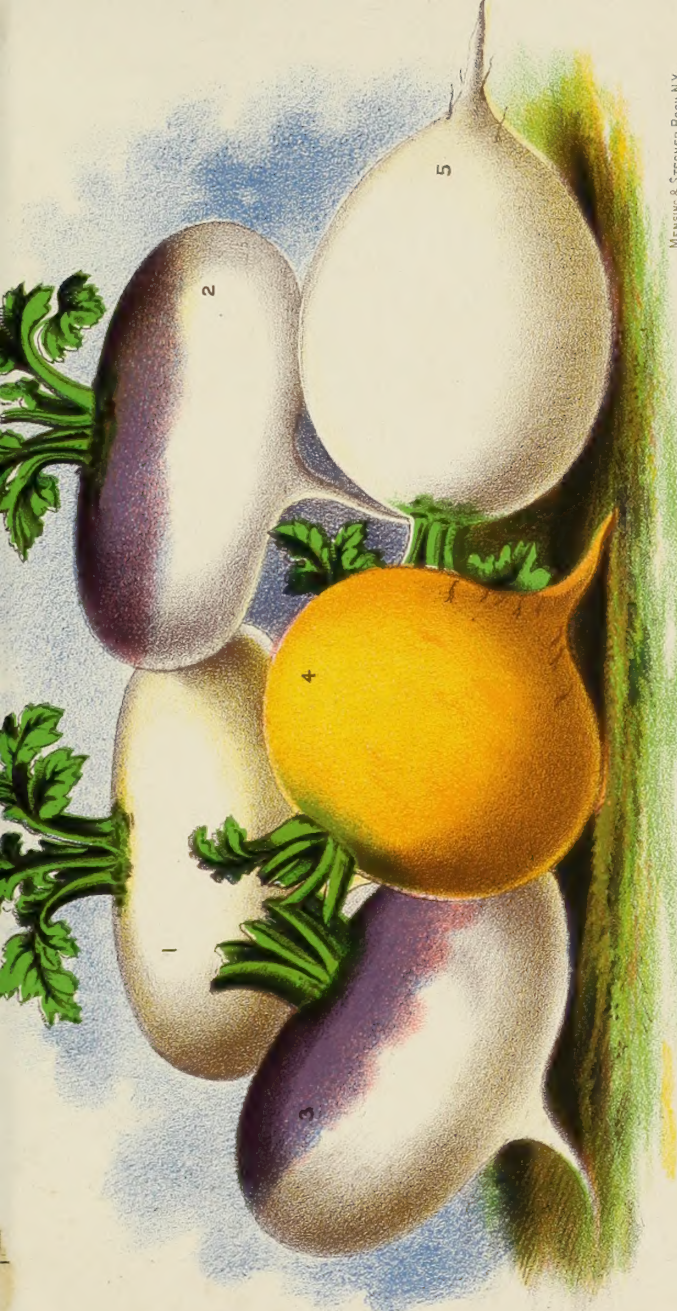
We make no charge for delivery at Freight or Express Office.

The "MEDITERRANEAN HYBRID" (Winter) WHEAT.

---

Originated in Western New York four years ago, by fertilizing the Red Mediterranean with the pollen of the Deihl.

It has proved to be extremely hardy, and very prolific, and has been pronounced by experts to be superior for flour.

It has the beard and blue straw of the Red Mediterranean, and the remarkably compact head, stiff straw, and plump berry of the Deihl. It stools so as to stand at least one-third thicker on the ground than Fultz, Clawson or Mediterranean.

We are expecting to be able to offer to the trade for sowing in Autumn of 1883, a goodly quantity of this valuable new Wheat.







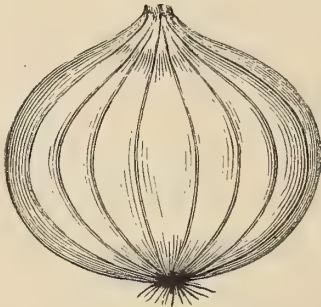

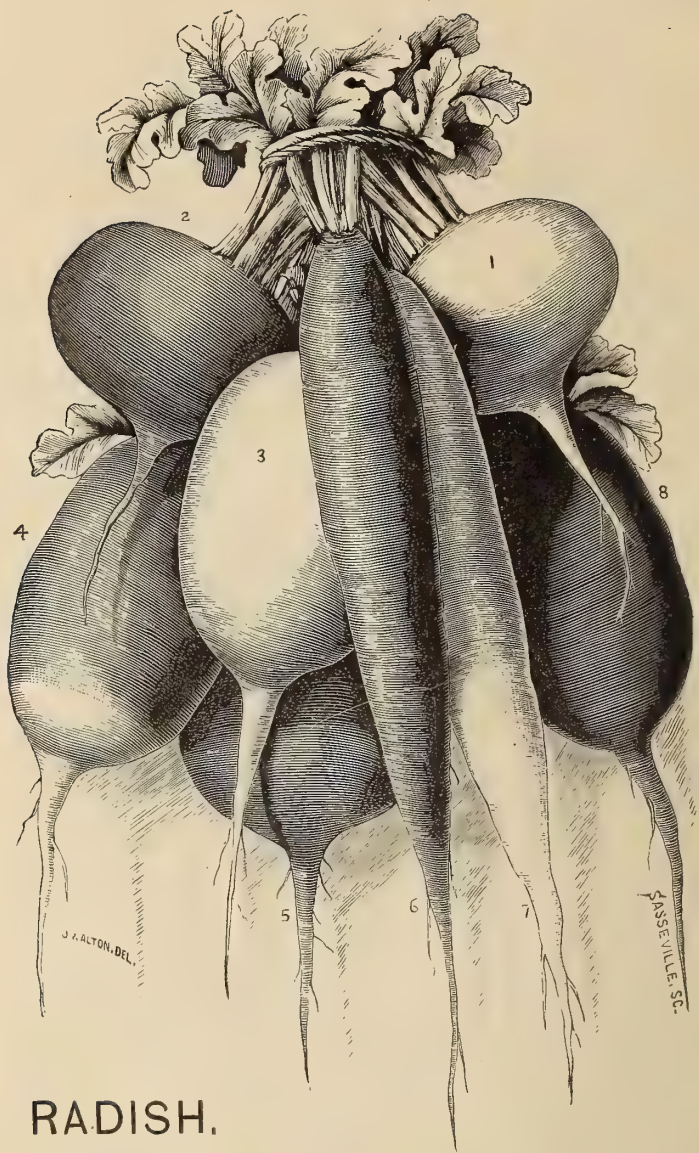
