All 12-18" are in 25's.

CONIFEROUS EVERGREENS

All of these Conifers are grown from cuttings and transplanted in the fields at least twice, except those marked "Pots" meaning grown in pots of the size specified. These field grown plants are not to be confused with bed or frame grown stock. They have grown at least one and in some instances two years in our full forty-two inch rows where they have had the assiduous care of an Alabama Darcy and his friend "The Mule." They have developed character, and will grow readily into dollars for you. They will be puddled in mud as dug and the roots carefully packed in sphagnum moss in ventilated cases for shipment. Potted stock will be shipped in paper pots of the size specified unless we are instructed to shake out.

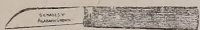

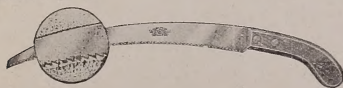
