Summary of Season

At the beginning practice of the Ahoskie High football season the outlook seemed grim indeed, for two of the starters were on the injured list. Billy Rogerson and Judson Eure were out by doctor's orders. But after a few days practice, the doctor allowed Judson to play and Billy started the Hertford game. Ahoskie rolled up victory after victory including a win over Plymouth who handed the '53 Indians their only loss. The outlook was bright but it was short-lived, for the principals of the Albemarle Conference met and voted to take the Ahoskie-Plymouth game from Ahoskie by forfeit, Ahoskie having played an illegal player for 30 seconds. The stunned Indians met Tarboro next and the outcome was a tie. The conference standings came out as a three way tie between Edenton, Ahoskie, and Plymouth. The deadlock was broken by a drawing from the hat. This was the third out of the past four years that the conference champs were decided by a hat. A comment was made that the conference name should be changed from the Albemarle Conference to "Hat Conference." Even though the Indians didn't win the state championship, they completed a successful season, having actually won nine out of ten games with one draw. The Greensboro paper rated Ahoskie the number one class "A" team in the state.
