Ten Senior Indians saw action for the last time against the Rich Square teanr. They were Pat Britton, Bobby Blaylock, Jack Bunch, Fred Bracy, Billy Asbell, Ralph Willoughby, Oliver Procter, Dan Ross, and Carlton Byrum.
