DEDICATION

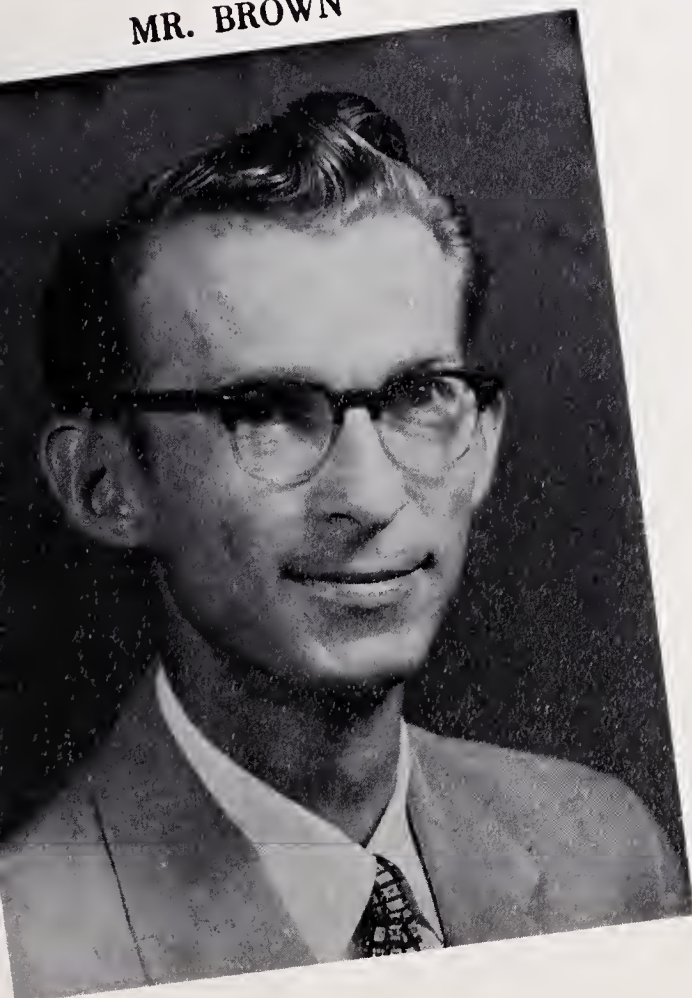

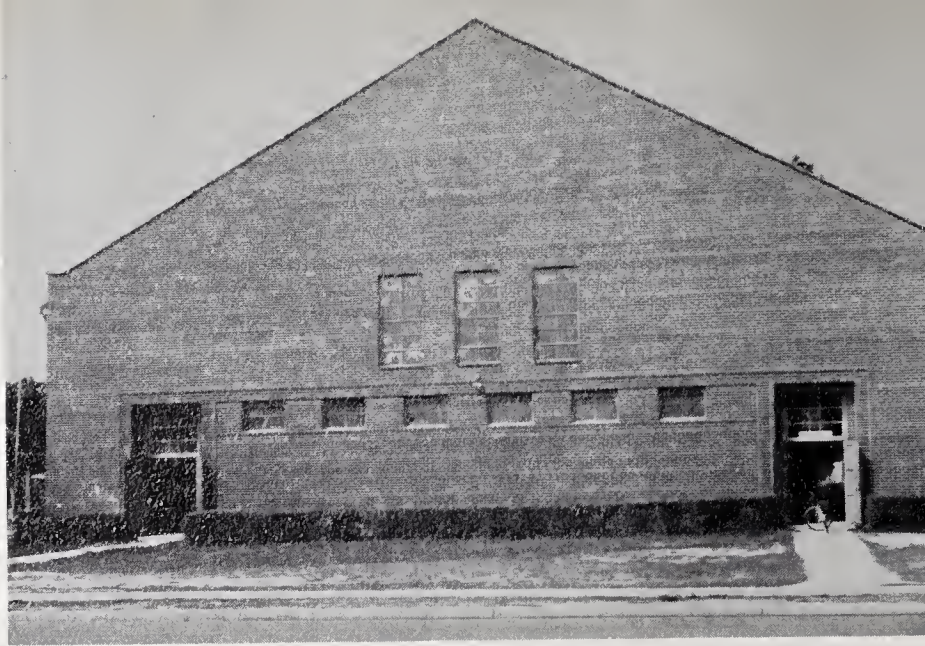

RALPH WILLOUGHBY, end, 6', 170 pounds. Senior. A hard worker. Should play good ball this year.

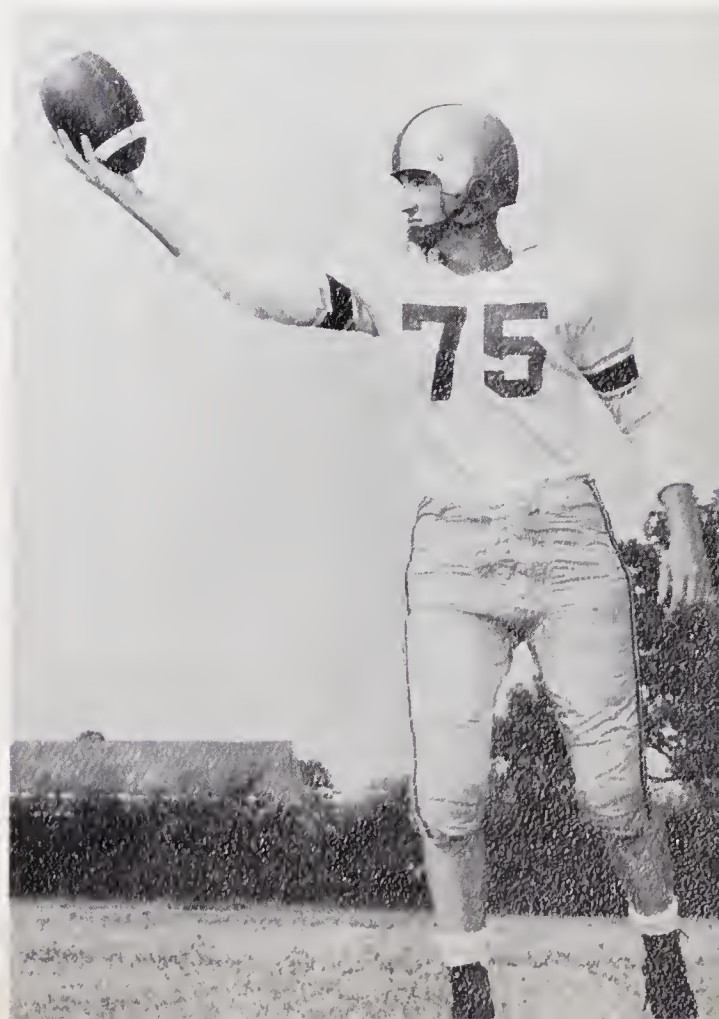


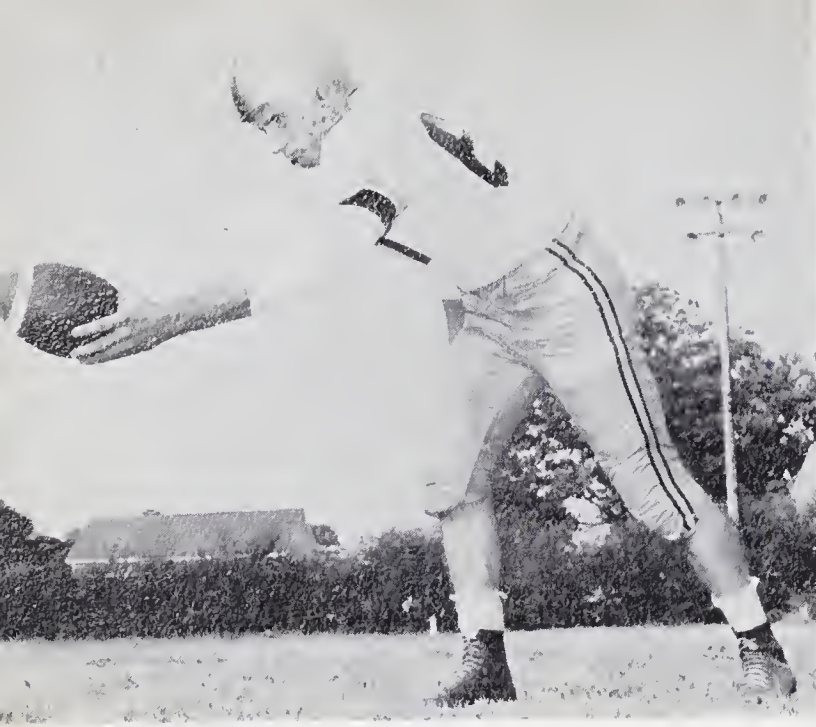

CARLTON BYRUM, guard, 5'11", 175 pounds. Senior. Played a lot of good ball on both offense and defense.

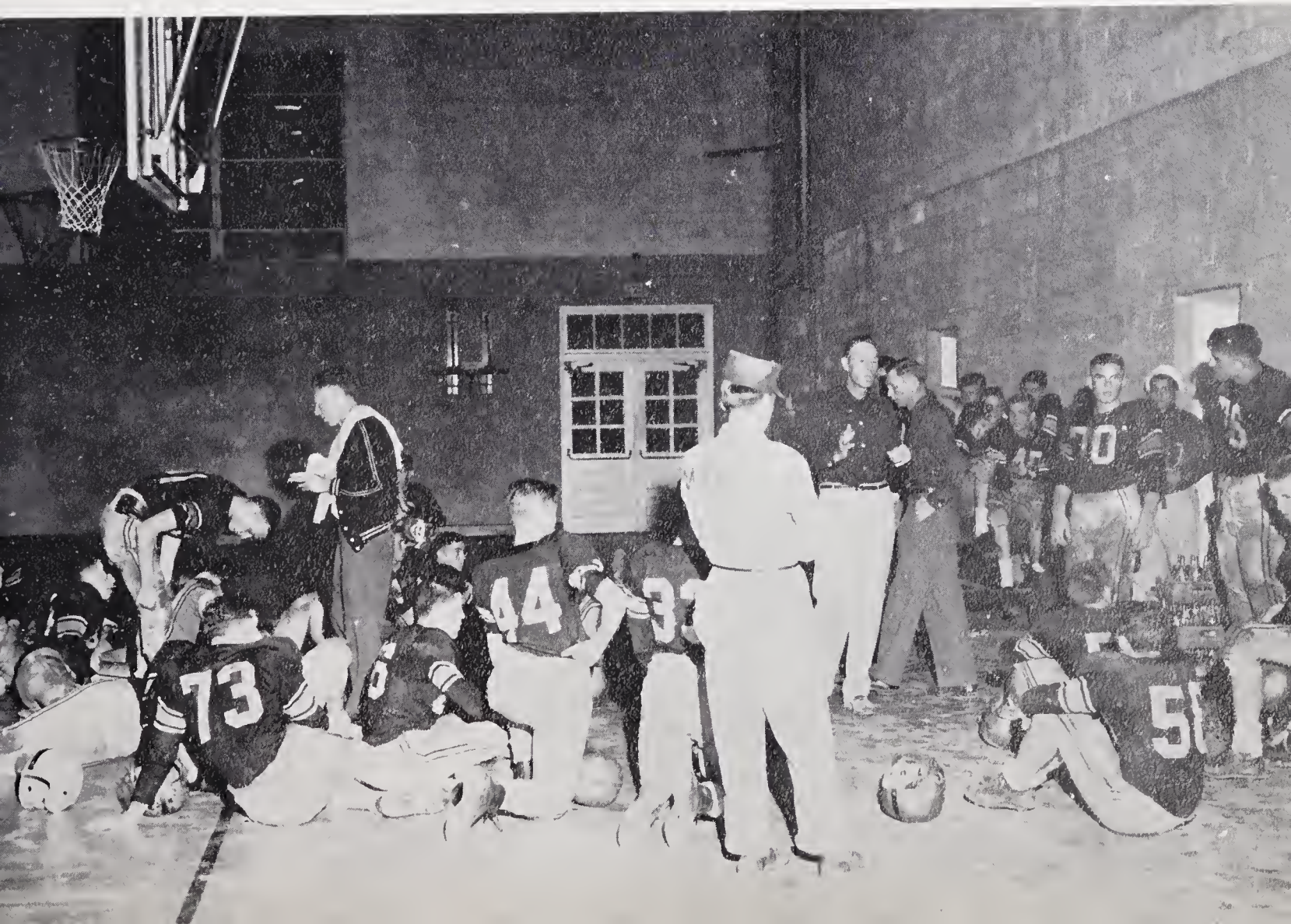


OLIVER PROCTOR, halfback, 5' 11", 163 pounds. Senior. First year out for football. Very fast. Developed fast.



The Season Reviewed

On August 15 the gridiron of AHS took on its back-to-football look. For on this date the 1955 Indians began to sharpen their weapons in order that they might go on a scalp hunt. The weapons were their passing, kicking, blocking, and running techniques. The scalp hunts are better known as the Albemarle Conference and the non-conference games. However, when the real hunts began the Indians found that their weapons were not quite sharp enough, for the Yellow Jackets of Oxford held them to a 12-12 tie. A week later when the Indians encountered another hive of swarming Yellow Jackets (Roanoke Rapids) they went to the dressing room after the final whistle with a sharp 7-0 stinging. These two unsuccessful hunts did nothing, however, to dampen the spirits of the war tribe from AHS. The tribe journeyed for three weeks from their own hunting grounds to those of other gridiron elevens. The Indians next felt the impact from the blows of a strong eleven, as the Edenton Aces dealt them a depressing defeat. The Indians went on from there to win the last two games of their regular season. Seven wins, one tie, and two losses, the scoring for the 1955 Indians, racked up. Ten Senior Indians saw action for the last time against the Rich Square team. They were Pat Britton, Bobby Blaylock, Jack Bunch, Fred Bracy, Billy Asbell, Ralph Willoughby, Oliver Procter, Dan Ross, and Carlton Byrum.



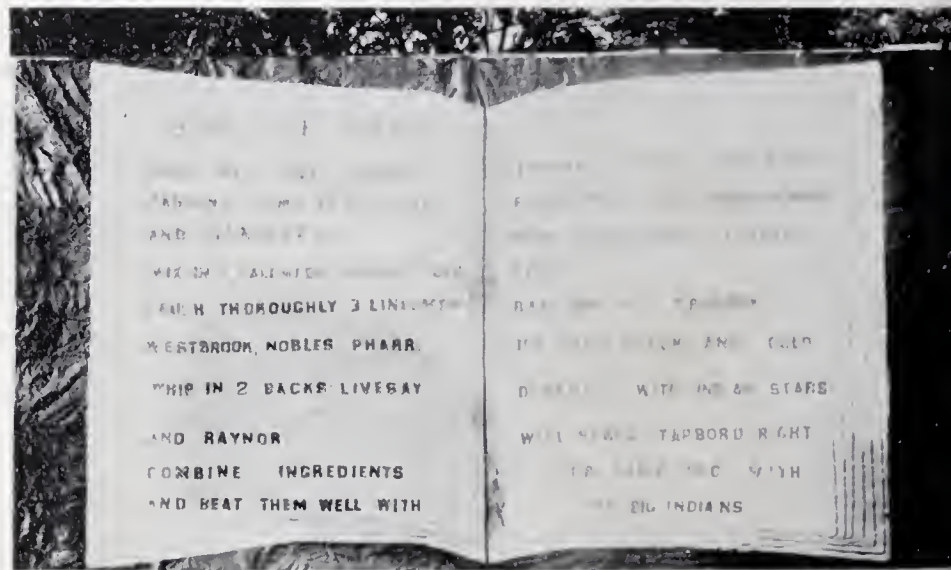
