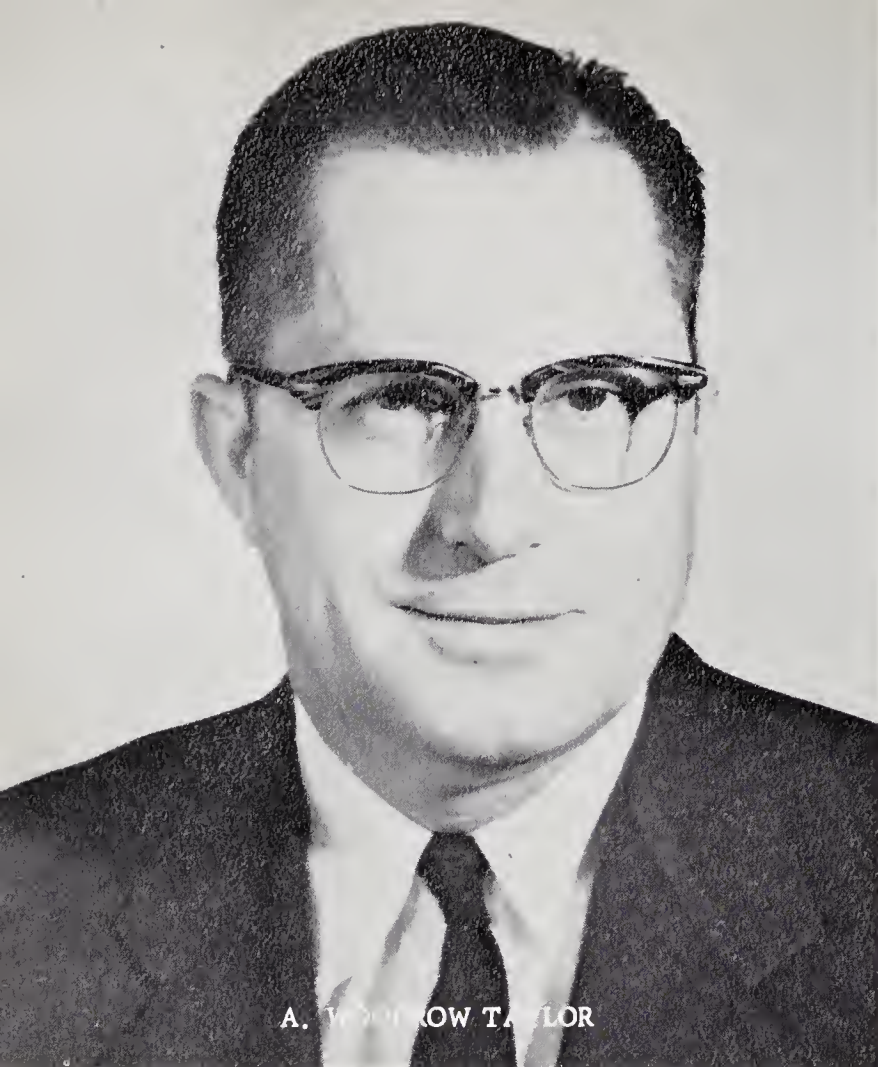


Dedication
