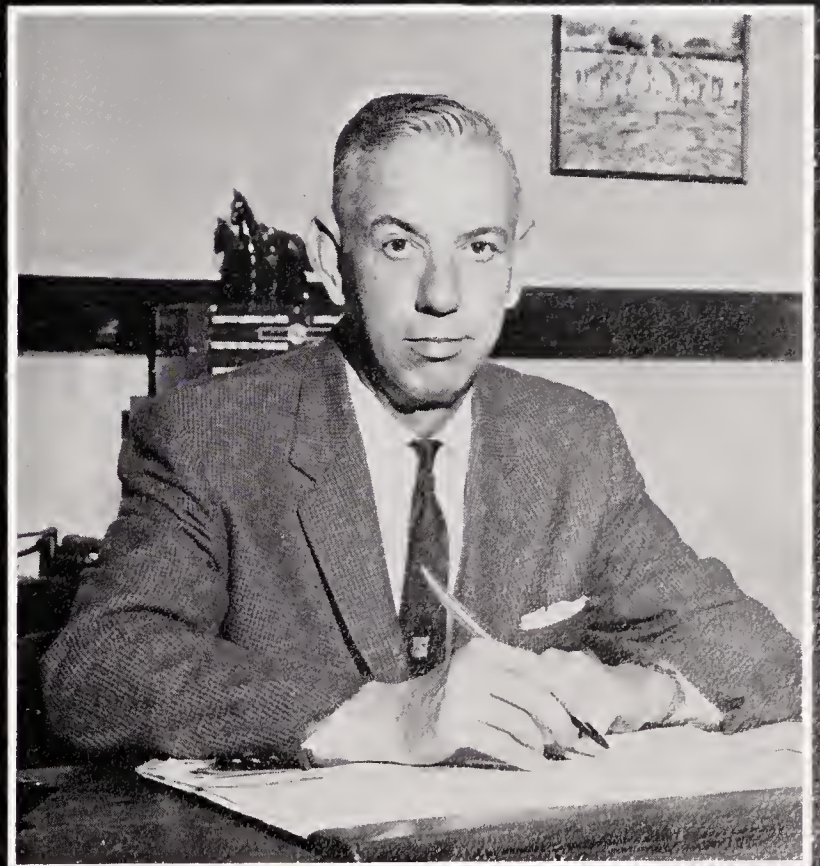
It is with admiration, the highest esteem and sincere appreciation that we dedicate this issue of our yearbook to Mr. and Mrs. Russell P. Martin.

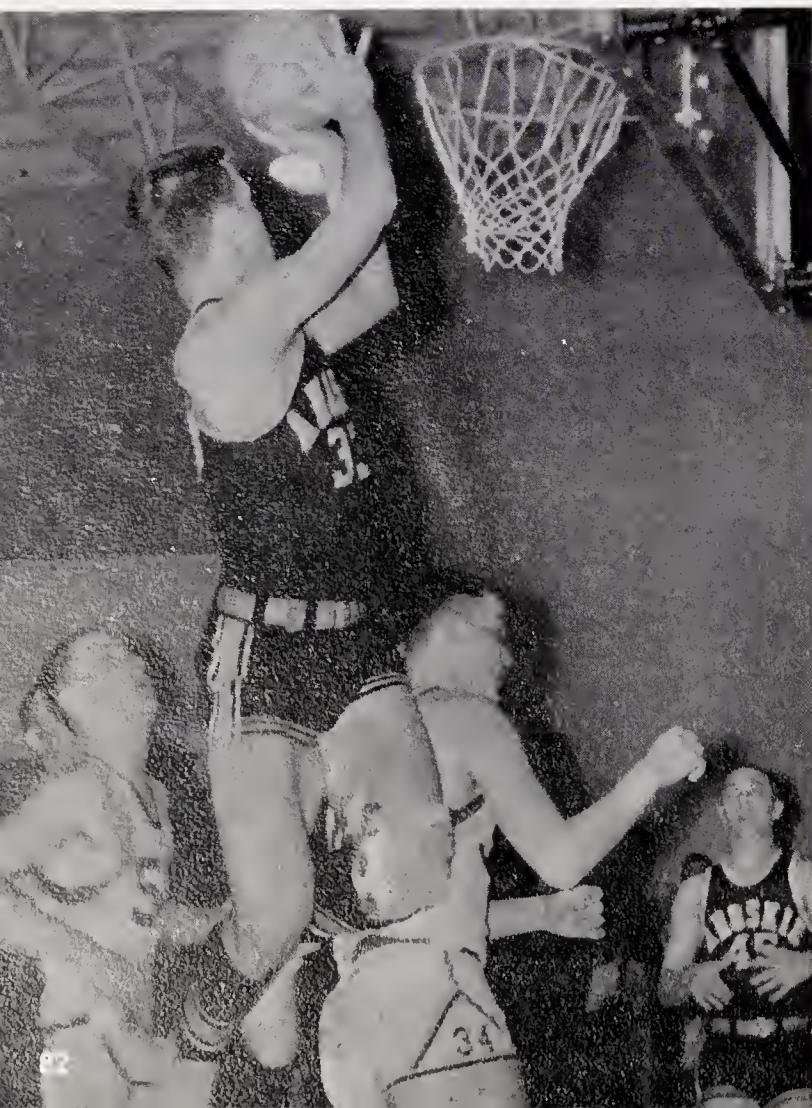
