
Principal's Message

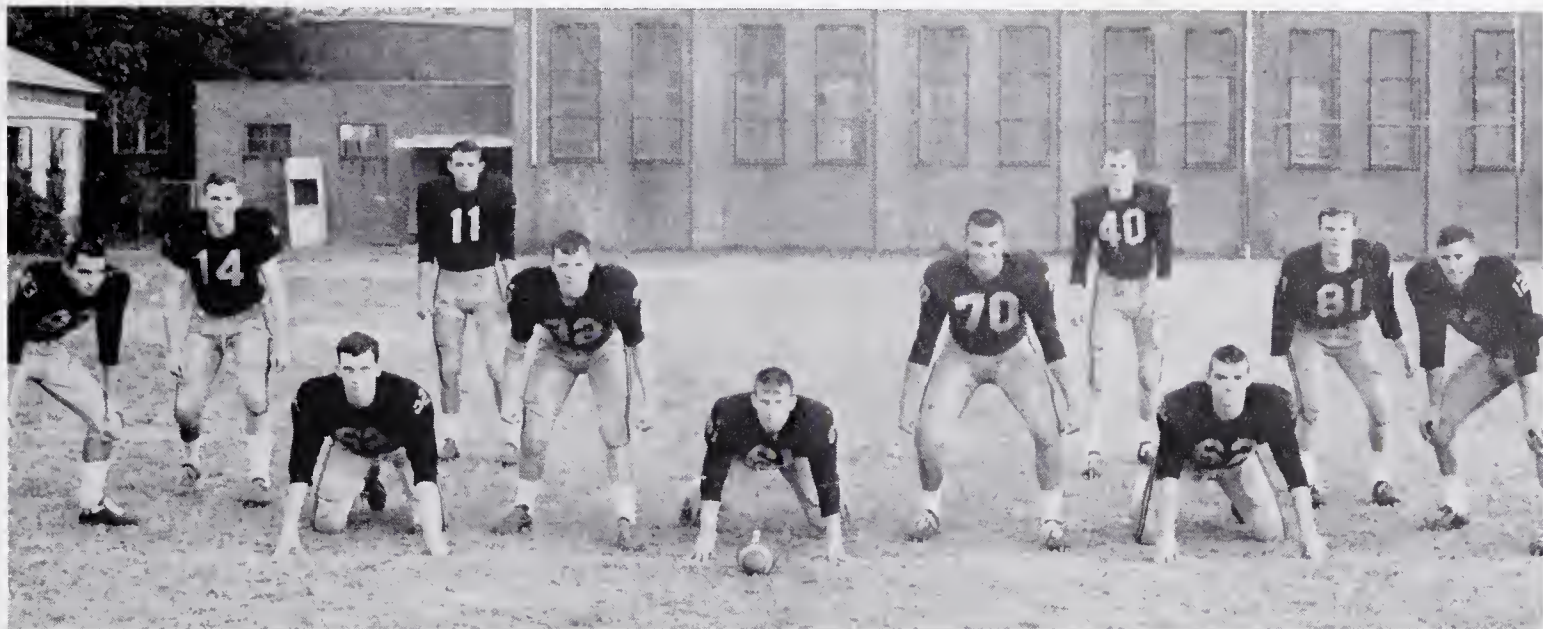
