Activities

The purpose of the Student Government Association of Pfeiffer College is to create an interest in self-government. Those who participate in this Student Association appreciate the feeling and understanding of a democratic society. This organization regulates all matters pertaining to the conduct of the students of Pfeiffer College.

A governing body, the Student Council, is set up under the Student Association. Officers of the Council are elected by the student body members. New members are initiated at the beginning of each fall and spring semester.

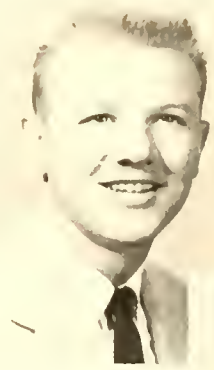
